## Group Discussion Prompt (60 min)

### **Open Pedagogy** (30 min)

What did you think about the argument that part of our social justice work in the classroom could be to include our students in the creation of knowledge and resources for the commons? How about the conversations about “disposable assignments” and their impact on student engagement? How can you see using open pedagogies/practices in our context?

### **Cohort reflection** (30 min)

During part 1 of this cohort, we dug into OER and copyright basics, culturally responsive teaching, universal design and open pedagogy.

- What is sticking with you?
- What do you want to do next? How will you continue to explore?
- What are you going to apply? How?

## Group Reflection

A brief (paragraph or so) post-discussion reflection should be submitted by 1 member from each group. This can be written, or, consider experimenting by submitting a short voice recording or video instead.

- What are your mini-group takeaways from the content and discussion this week?
- Were there sticking points or difficulties that you navigated during this discussion?
