Missions:

Missions for each game will be determined between each player based on their force disposition using missions from the Chapter Approved 2026-27: Mission Deck, detailed below.

We will be using GW appropriate terrain for the new map layouts for 11th edition.

Scoring:

The 10 points which would be awarded for painting will instead be awarded to games that finish naturally within the time limit (not talked out), current round points can be calculated if agreed between the players if the time runs out mid round but this would not grant you the 10 points for finishing naturally on time (TO help is available to finalise round points). Future round points cannot be theorised.

Armies:

The points limit for this event is 2000 points. All armies must be battleforged for Chapter Approved Matchplay missions - No Legends Units.

Lists should be submitted via Best Coast pairings Your warlord, any enhancements, and any other pre-game stratagems should be included in your list. If you have any questions or need help with this, please contact the Organiser.

Conversions and proxy models will be permitted, however they must be an appropriate representation of the model, this means it should be the right size and approximate silhouette and loadout and must be approved for use by the Tournament Organiser before the event

There are no painting requirements for this event, as they are designed to encourage newer players to attend or for players to try out new armies.

Player Conduct:

Hobby Master 40k tournaments are run in collaboration with the Warhammer 40k New Zealand Tournament Organisers Association which aims to promote a positive 40k competitive play experience for all who participate, full code of conduct rules can be found [here](#).

The Hobby Master 40k events are designed for players at all levels and therefore you should be prepared to face newer players or seasoned players with competitive army lists. Players are expected to play with sportsmanship in mind to ensure your opponents have a good game and likewise be gracious in victory or defeat.

As the event is taking place in the store that is open to the public we expect players to conduct themselves as per the store's code of conduct rules which are posted throughout the store.

Players should feel confident and comfortable in calling on the TO for any rules clarification or judgements.

The use of Chess clocks is not required for this event, however, if a player does wish to use a chess clock for a game then it must be permitted. Please note that if players are wishing to use a chess clock, then they must bring their own.

Best Painted:

Each player can select one of their models to put forward for the best painted award. This must be a model being used in the tournament (**proxy models cannot be submitted for Best painted award**) and should be painted by the player (this is an honour system, we cannot enforce this as we will not know who has painted what and cannot claw this back later, so please only submit something that you have painted yourself) During the first battle round the TO will hand out a number to each player which is to be placed in front of the selected model in an area for displaying the submission. You will also be given a voting form for you to be able to vote for which model you think is painted the best (please do not vote for your own model, it is tracked and will often count against you if your vote causes you to get the most votes or if there is a tie).
