SPECIAL NOTES ON CBM READING:

*As we begin, teachers do not have to use Error Tracking in CBM Reading to identify the type of error. If you want to try using Error Tracking, start small, and try just one type of error.

*CBM Reading also provides teachers with an opportunity to administer the [CBMReading Comprehension](#) measure. This is **not** universally required at this time, but it is available as an option if you are looking for a reliable comprehension measure for a student.

ASSESSMENT PLAN:

*RSU 13 will still continue to use the **25th percentile** to make RTI recommendations and decisions. **!** shows Some Risk from the 11th percentile to the 25th percentile, and **!!** shows High Risk from the 0 to the 10th percentile.

*Progress Monitoring will occur **every week, with a minimum of 4 data points/6 week period**. Review of progress monitoring will occur **every 6 weeks**. Teachers should be looking at the national percentiles.

REPORTS TO RUN:

FastBridge has a robust reporting system with lots of valuable data. You will not learn how to use all of the reports right away, so use the table below to make determinations with data as we get started. Feel free to explore what other reports have to offer.

CERTIFICATIONS:

Working through modules will provide you with certifications in each screening assessment as well as in reports and progress monitoring. Access these modules by going to the “Training and Resources” tab at the top of your screen after logging into your account. You will be provided with .5 contact hours per completed module. A report of certifications will be run in January and June with contact hours provided at those times. For the first year of implementation, certification is not required to screen or progress monitor students, but it is highly recommended.
