

Also, I wanted to show how the COVID-19 tracking app called "eRouška", developed by the Ministry of health in the Czech Republic, works if you have been in contact with a person who got tested positive. This application helps prevent and find risky encounters and uses Apple and Google API that signals about 100% privacy of information shared between people.
