Step 4: Make your remaining choices for a total of eight primary course selections. When you are finished, your number of A/B classes should be an even number and your number of semester classes should be an even number, including your Freshman Academy Courses.

Step 5: Make your alternate course choices. Select four semester courses OR four A/B courses OR two semester and two A/B courses.
