Job Duties

- Develop cheers for outdoor fall & indoor winter contests
- Develop stunting for outdoor fall & indoor winter contests
- Ensure all appropriate safety guidelines and standards are maintained
- Perform specific coaching and instructional responsibilities during athletic events (games)

Time Commitment

- About 2 hours per day for practices, this includes set-up and tear-down of equipment
 - Practices can be scheduled any day of the week
 - 1-3 practices per week depending on game schedule, games/practices cannot occur more than 6 consecutive days
- Games are once a week in the fall (August-October) & usually 2-3 times a week (November-February) for the Winter season.
