Library Books

Fines - End of the Year

If your student has lost/damaged a school item (library book, classroom book, textbook, calculator, chromebook etc.) or has a negative balance in their breakfast/lunch account, these must be paid before field day or students will not be allowed to participate. Attention 6th Grade Parents - Time for Immunizations!

State law requires all incoming 7th grade students to be vaccinated against Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (TDAP) as well as Meningococcal Conjugate before starting the school year. Students who do not have up-to-date immunizations may be excluded from attending school. Many students have already received these required vaccines during a well-child visit to their primary care provider. Parents and guardians can find out if a child has had these vaccines by looking at the child's vaccine record or by checking with the family's primary care physician. If you have an objection to any of the immunizations that are required by the Michigan Public Health Code, please contact the Shiawassee County Health Department to complete the process of obtaining an immunization waiver. This waiver must also be completed and submitted to the office by the start of the school year. Please consider making sure your child has his/her shots or a waiver ASAP to avoid having them miss school this fall. Thank you in advance for your help with getting this completed on time!

Medicine in the Office

If your child had medicine that they took here at school during the year, please make arrangements to pick it up prior to June 9. Anything left at that point will be safely discarded.
