If you are a graduating senior from any Coffee County High School and planning to enroll at Wiregrass you may qualify for a \$1,000.00 scholarship (divided over two semesters.)

QUALIFICATIONS:

Recipient must:

- Submit an application to the WGTC Foundation North
- Submit answers to the questions on the back of the application sheet
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Must choose one of the following fields of study: Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Business, Education or Healthcare
- Graduate Coffee High School
- Demonstrate financial need
- Strong involvement in civic or school related clubs/organizations
- Strong work ethic
- Possess strong leadership abilities or potential

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- This is a \$500 scholarship to be presented to two students
- To be eligible, student must be a senior from Coffee County
- Scholarship can be used for tuition, books, supplies, equipment, or any items the student needs to succeed in school.
- If the selected student does not use all of the scholarship while in school, the remainder can be used for work clothing or supplies/equipment needed for employment.
- If the student withdraws from WGTC for any reason, the remaining part of the scholarship is void and the remaining funds will be given to the next qualified applicant.
- The WGTC Foundation office will ensure the student writes a progress note to the donor each semester.
- All WGTC majors are eligible for scholarship consideration.
- Only completed applications will be considered.
- Acceptance of this award will not preclude the student from receiving other financial aid for which he/she may be eligible.
