As the GSS is administered to U.S. citizens every year, there is an online resource to see the latest social problems data.

To see updated data, go on the <u>GSS Data Explorer webpage</u>, click on "Search Variables," and type a keyword related to the topic of interest. Click on the variable of interest and it will show how people responded in all the years this survey question was asked. You can also click on the "Trends" tab and select a general area of interest to see a graphical representation of how the data has changed over time.
