Whereas, the governing board of [DISTRICT] School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on [BRD MTG DATE] at [BRD MTG TIME]., which is on or before the eighth week of school **(between the first day that students attend school and the eighth week from that day)** and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

Whereas, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional material” means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

Whereas, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, which are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:
