# How to Worship God According to the Tabernacle Pattern

Inspired by Pastor Cho's Tabernacle Prayer

## **Overview**

I first discovered the Tabernacle Prayer in 2002 at the World Prayer Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado. For over 12 years now, this pattern of worship has transformed my life, as well as my family. My wife's walk with Christ has been forever changed. Even my eldest daughter (age 22) has been deeply impacted by praying the Tabernacle prayer.

I have been a Christian for almost 40 years now. I can say for certain that Tabernacle Prayer has deepened our walk with Christ, expanded our knowledge of, and love for the Scriptures, and helped us to love one another in a life giving way. Our everyday walk with Christ has been deepened because Tabernacle prayer takes information in the Bible and embeds it into our heart, breaking off old habits, and building new ones based on God's Word. What God continues to do in us, as we worship Him, is truly miraculous in our family.

To help others learn Tabernacle Prayer, we have discovered a few things over the years.

1) Tabernacle Prayer is not a prayer found in the Bible like the Lord's Prayer. It is a process or pattern for worshipping God. The pattern is derived from the central form of worship in the bible, the Tabernacle of Moses and Solomon's Temple. There are more chapters devoted to descriptions of this form of worship than any other single subject in the bible. The tabernacle worship pattern was established by God in heaven and given to both Moses and David as the way God wanted his people to worship Him. This way...no other. This pattern strictly adhered to.. Here are some key passages:

2) Pastor Cho, now retired founder and leader of the Yoido Full Gospel Church, the largest church in the world, testifies that God gave him the tabernacle prayer over 50 years ago, he has prayed it for hours each day for 50 years. He credits the great success in his church and ministry to this particular process of prayer. This speaks volumes to anyone with an ear to hear.

Since the tabernacle is represented throughout the Bible, in many different ways, we must see that this tabernacle worship is a definite type of worship which God wants. Based on the bible, tabernacle worship is in our past, it's in our future, and it's in us today. God tells us that "we are temples of the Holy Ghost."

All the tabernacles built by men are no longer standing. Temples build by God however are growing more numerous every day. You see, today, we as individuals, we are the temple of God on earth. The Body of Christ is the Temple of God. The body of Christ together is being built up into a grand temple of God across the earth. Each individual believer, is according to Scripture, a living stone in this temple corporately, and each of our bodies are called Temples in Scripture. Why? Because God lives in us.

This is our difference as New Testament believers. We are not pursuing God somewhere over there. God is with us. God lives in us. We are temples of Holy Spirit.

So there is great blessing for us in learning the truths of Temple worship as given to us by the Lord in the Scriptures. Since he is God, why not minister to the Lord, and allow Him to minister to us... according to His ways? Why substitute our own ways based on our culture, tradition, or personal preference? Why not worship God's His way?

If we choose to worship God according to his prescribed ways, then we must go back and look for instructions based on what God told His people to do under the new and old covenants. We would look for ways of Worshipping God that are centered around the Temple and then around our Lord Jesus Christ. Are not his ways higher than our ways? Perhaps there is a reason he told us to worship him in very specific ways. Perhaps there are lessons and blessings for us in His ways of worship. Most Christians that has taken this prayer pattern seriously for a few weeks will have a story to tell about how special and unique it is.

Jesus called his own body "the temple". Paul said our bodies are temples of the Holy Ghost. So when we pray in our temple, our physical being, in our imaginations we can go through the tabernacle and worship God according to God's temple worship pattern.

Would you commit to trying this for 7 days and see what happens?

From experience, we have found that the best way to begin, is just by simply praying the written prayers out loud. The written prayers are based on others, like Pastor Cho, who have been praying according to the tabernacle pattern for decades and seeing tremendous fruit from it. After you learn the basics, you can look up Scriptures yourself on various aspects of the tabernacle, and pray those as well. Ask Holy Spirit to lead you during your tabernacle prayer times and see what happens!

## The Layout of the Tabernacle

The pattern of tabernacle worship is based on the identification and meaning of the furnishings in the rooms in the tabernacle. The pattern is based on the function of the tabernacle. And how the priests were instructed to minister in each place as they approached God to worship Him. References to the eternal temple in heaven, the original temple, include similar worship descriptions.

Moses writes that God gave him the heavenly pattern and told him to build it exactly according to the heavenly pattern.

David also had the pattern given to him by God. And he was told to use this pattern in helping his son Solomon build the permanent Temple in Jerusalem.

We see Haggai and Ezra rebuilding the Temple according to these same ways.

We see Jesus zealously guarding his Father's House. Herod's Temple, was built on the same foundations as Solomon's Temple.

We see the descriptions of future temples in Ezekiel and Zechariah and Isaiah utilizing the same basic priestly worship pattern and processes.

Based on this overwhelming evidence we need to seriously consider the Lord's ways of worship and investigate how they may apply to us because we are his Temple on earth today. We are priests in our physical temples, which are our bodies.

In awe of your creation and how life continues to reproduce life and grow. How all the planets remain in order and function. How the bees pollinate the fruit trees. How babies grow up in the womb.

You are my father in heaven and I will love you today through obedience to you and your ways.

Jesus you are my Lord and I will love you today through faithfulness to you and your Word.

Holy Spirit you are my guide and my counselor and my helper. I will love you today and listen to your guidance and obey your direction and commands.

## How to Pray the Temple Prayer

Begin by slowly praying outloud the "PRAY" parts. You may read or pray the "READ" parts.

#### **PRAY**

Father I desire to worship you today.
I desire to humble myself before you right now. (pause)
You are the God of all creation!
You are the God of the Bible!
You are calling me into my future with you!
You are my God today!
I worship you heavenly Father!
(pause)

Jesus, I worship you as my God.
You are the Son of God.
You are my Lord!
I am with you in heavenly places.
I desire to humble myself before you today.
(pause)

Holy Spirit, you are the third person of the Trinity.
You are my God.
You are my guide, my helper, my counselor.
Please lead me and guide me today during this prayer time.
I desire to hear your voice and obey you.
(pause)

My Lord, I love you.

I place my faith and trust in you today.

You are always faithful to me.

You never leave me or forsake me.

I want to draw near to you, to come into your Presence.

I want to dwell with you, in your House today -- to worship You.

I come boldly before the Throne of Grace today!

(pause)

#### **READ**

Lord, It was You who commanded Moses to build the tabernacle in the wilderness. Lord, you dwelt there and met your people there. The Israelites only worshipped You in that tabernacle. The Tabernacle clearly illustrates Your pattern of worship. It reveals eternal truths about how to worship You! I desire to do things your way today.

I thank you for the tabernacle model through Moses.

I thank you that Jesus had a zeal for your house and called His own body the temple. I ask for that same zeal today.

Help me to see that the original Temple has always been in Heaven.

I know that Jesus went away to prepare a place for the me and my family in your Magnificent House in Heaven.

#### **PRAY**

Today by faith You dwell in me.

According to Your Word – My body is your temple.

Come, Lord Jesus!

Work through my spirit, through my mind, through my body.

Through the temple of my body, I directly worship you, Lord.

I am a priest unto the Lord today.

Jesus, You are the High Priest of Heaven.

Teach me my priestly duties today.

Teach me according to your ordained pattern of worship.

## Station 1 - GRATITUDE AT THE GATE

#### **READ**

As we enter the tabernacle we notice there is only one way in, through the eastern gate. All people who approach God must come through Jesus Christ, the one gate he supplied. Jesus is the gate for the sheep and we come and go out through him to find pasture.

Jesus said: "Yes, I am the gate. Those who come in through me will be saved. They will come and go freely and will find good pastures." Joh 10:9 (NLT)

#### **PRAY**

"Dear Jesus thank you that you are my gate into the House of the Lord for all eternity. I come into the Father's presence by believing in you Jesus and in you alone.

There is no other way to God.

There is no other way to heaven.

I am so thankful for your house, the tabernacle.

So thankful that you want to dwell in me, and make me your dwelling place.

I am a temple of the Holy Ghost.

I am no longer a stranger or foreigner to God.

As I believe in Jesus Christ, I welcome the Spirit of God into me.

Come Holy Spirit.

Please give me a heart of gratitude today.

Please give me a humble heart that trusts you completely.

By faith I come through the gate into your courtyard oh Lord.

### Station 2 - BRAZEN ALTAR - FAITH IN THE BLOOD

#### **READ**

As a child of God we receive an incredible inheritance. The benefits of the blood covenant are many. The more we pray about what Jesus has accomplished for us, the stronger our faith in Jesus becomes.

As I come through the gate, I see the Tabernacle Courtyard in my mind. Right in front of me I see the Brazen Altar. Here the priest killed the animals, sprinkled the blood, and burned the flesh to forgive the sins of the people. All the people who had committed sins had to bring their own animals to the tabernacle. As soon as they stepped into the courtyard of the tabernacle they saw the brazen altar where God judged sin by killing innocent animals. Lambs were sacrificed morning and evening for the sins of the people.

#### THE CROSS

Now I rejoice because one day 2000 years ago Jesus came to be the final lamb sacrifice. He was and is "the Lamb of God." The brazen altar is no longer needed. The cross of Jesus Christ has replaced it. Jesus is the lamb of God who took away the sins of the world.

Likewise when we worship God, we must start at the cross. We so quickly take the cross, and the atonement of the blood for granted. Yet there are so many blessings that we receive through the blood of Christ. It is very important for our own faith that we remember the benefits of the blood covenant.

## A. BRAZEN ALTAR HAS BEEN REPLACED BY THE CROSS READ

Everyday come to the cross and remember the benefits of the blood of Jesus. Just as God the Father judged the sin of Israel through the animals, God now sees my sins as judged and wiped off my record through the blood of Jesus Christ. This is a very serious thing.

#### **PRAY**

Dear Jesus Christ. Thank you for your death on the Cross.

I worship You and your Blood sacrifice for me.

It is finished!

You have saved me from my sins!

I thank you that your blood forgives me today of all of my sins.

Thank you Father for forgiving me through Jesus and His sacrifice on my behalf. You have forgiven me eternally.

There is no condemnation for me, in Christ Jesus!"

#### **B. GRACE IS RELEASED FOR ME**

#### **PRAY**

Jesus grace and truth have come through you.

I am a child of grace.

I did not deserve it but you offer me forgiveness, and a place in your family because of your great love for me and for all people.

You are the God of unmerited favor.

Your love and forgiveness know no bounds.

Thankyou for grace today!

I see Your redeeming grace flow to me now. 1CO 15:57

Through grace I am saved and receive so many benefits!

#### C. I AM DELIVERED FROM SIN & DEATH

#### **PRAY**

"Thank you Lord that I need not fear death from sin any longer.

You have conquered death.

Thanks be to God that I have victory over sin and death, through my Lord Jesus Christ. I am redeemed from death and hell.

Through My Lord's death on the cross, through His resurrection, and through His ascension, Death and hell have been permanently conquered. This victory is mine through Jesus Christ.

## D. I AM DELIVERED FROM THE POWER OF SATAN AND THE WORLD PRAY

Jesus I thank you that through your blood you have delivered me from the power of Satan and the world.

You have moved me out of the kingdom of darkness and into the Kingdom of my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

I renounce all influences satan uses over me. (be specific for yourself as the Lord reminds you)

I renounce all worldliness, in Jesus's name. (be specific for yourself as the Lord reminds you)

Today I live in my Father's Kingdom, the Kingdom of my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Bye bye devil. Bye bye worldliness. Hello Kingdom of God in me!

Lord, give me sanctification and fullness of the Holy Spirit through the blood of Jesus. Any hold that the world or the devil has on me is canceled and broken right now in Jesus's name!

Because of the blood of Jesus, I am free!

### E. MY IDENTITY IS IN JESUS - Sons & Daughters

#### **PRAY**

Lord, Clarify my vision of myself as an adopted child of God.

The blood of Jesus Christ signs my adoption papers in heaven.

Legally I am a (son) (daughter) of God.

I am no longer an orphan.

I am a (son) (daughter) of the most high.

Thank you Lord that I am a member of your family of priests.

Make me aware of my new identity.

I am a new person in you today, a new creation through the blood of Jesus Christ.

I no longer have an identity crisis.

I have a clear identity in Jesus Christ!

I will not sign for the devil's packages today.

My mind is no longer victimized by the devil's lies.

I am a NEW CREATURE, a NEW CREATION.

I AM HOLY.

I am SANCTIFIED.

I am BLESSED:

the GLORY OF GOD IS IN ME!

#### F. I AM HEALED IN JESUS'S NAME

#### **PRAY**

Jesus through the stripes which you received at the Courtyard of Pilot,

you have conquered sickness, disease, and death.

You released the power of your blood.

Your blood is more powerful than any illness.

I declare that because of the blood of Jesus Christ, I am healed from every sickness and disease.

I praise you for divine healing through the blood of Jesus Christ.

You hung on the cross and took my infirmities – I am healed.

Sickness and disease is illegal in me.

I am healed today!
My mind is healed in Jesus's Name!
My Body is healed in Jesus name!
Thank you Father! Thank you Jesus! Thank you Holy Sorit!

#### G. DECLARED RIGHTEOUS

#### **PRAY - DECLARE**

I believe the Cross of Jesus Christ replaces the Brazen Altar for me today.

The blood of Jesus Christ replaces the blood of animals for me – one sacrifice for all time through Jesus Christ.

My sin is forgiven – I am declared righteous through the Cross. No guilt and shame for me today; I have a clean slate.

#### H. ENJOY GLORY

#### **PRAY - DECLARE**

I will enjoy the Glory of God today. The Shekinah Glory is in me.

#### I. REDEEMED FROM THE CURSE

#### **PRAY**

Through the Cross – through your blood – I am redeemed from the curse.

The blood of Jesus speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

You hung on a tree so the Abrahamic blessing would be mine.

I am a blessed person!

I am no longer under the curse.

I am under the blessing of Jesus Christ today – in my home, work, ministry and family. There is no poverty – no curse for me. You became poor for me so that I can be rich in Jesus Christ.

In Christ I am redeemed completely from any negative thinking. No cloudy thinking for me today – only clarity on my freedom from the curse and freedom from poverty.

This is a major blessing of the blood of Jesus Christ.

#### J. RENEWED MIND

#### **PRAY - DECLARE**

Thank you, Lord Jesus, that my mind is renewed in you when I pray this way, claiming these truths, worshipping you.

Thank you for renewing me from a mind that was clogged with lies and negative thoughts.

I will have nothing to do with the filthy things of this world.

I reject all the lies the devil tries to tell me.

I renounce the lie that ....(insert a lie you have believed about yourself)

I cut off every tie with the dark side in Jesus's name.

No more self-FAILING prophecy for me.

God-FULFILLING prophecy is mine in Jesus Name.

Everyday that I renew my mind, I confirm and affirm my new identity.

I worship Jesus and His sacrifice FOR ME.

## Station 3 - PURIFICATION AT THE LAVER

#### **RFAD**

Here, we clean and purify our consciences every day, like taking a bath or shower to clean our bodies. The priests wash their hands, feet and face at the Laver. In the New Testament water is where we are baptized into new life in Christ. Water is also a purifying stream that flows out of us as we allow Holy Spirit to operate through us. In heaven the laver is a river of pure water that brings life to all as if flows out from the Temple in heaven. Before I go into the Holy Place, I look at myself in the Laver —what is wrong in my heart. I reflect on the 10 commandments and purify my conscience by washing myself through repentance and confession of sin consciousness. The best and most thorough way to do this is by reflecting on the ten commandments. ADD SCRIPTURE LINK

#### **PRAY**

Lord, at the Laver I Invite You to expose Sin In Me.
I desire a clear conscience today.
I cannot drag my guilty conscience into your presence,
Lord. You won't allow it.

Commandment 1 – Do I worship any other Gods? Do I put myself (self worship) ahead of (worship of Jesus)? There is only one God, in three persons: Father, Son, Holy Spirit.

Forgive me, Lord, for dishonoring you by entertaining other gods.

Commandment 2 – Do I bow to any idols? Have I placed my role as husband/wife, father/mother

, career person ahead of my role as a priest unto the Lord? Am I giving the first fruits of my day to something else? Am I worshiping graven images of money or power? Am I worshipping any false ideas about Jesus?

Forgive me for dishonoring you by worshipping idols and graven images. You alone are the one true God. Jesus you are the perfect image of the Father. I seek your face today.

Commandment 3 – Do I call God's name in vain – any of God's names? Forgive me for dishonoring you by taking any of your names in vain.

Commandment 4 – Do I honor God by keeping the Sabbath Holy?

Am I paying tithes and keeping the Sabbath before expecting blessing from Lord?

Forgive me for dishonoring your Sabbath commandment. Teach me your ways! Forgive me for not being a more cheerful giver Lord. Teach me your ways!

Commandment 5 - Do I honor my parents or blame my parents for my problems?

Do I dishonor those you put in authority over me – pastors, government leaders, school boards etc.?

Do I gossip about them?

Forgive me, Father, for the negative influence of American culture that disrespects our parents and dishonors You. May I be free today from that influence. Forgive me for dishonoring my parents and any in authority over me. And where is the honor due You? Forgive me for dishonoring You, my Father in heaven whenever I do not pay my tithes. I recognize that how I manage my money is a direct reflection of how I worship you.

Commandment 6 - Do I kill by hating? In what ways am I programming my mind or the minds of my children to hate or be angry or hold prejudice against anyone?

I forgive others right now. I release all offenses. I repent of any angry words spoken. Forgive me for dishonoring you through angry words and hatred. O Lord, deliver me from an angry, bitter heart. Only you can do this. I have failed in controlling anger that rises up in me. Only you can give me the grace to have victory over anger today.

Commandment 7 - Do I commit adultery or entertain lustful thoughts?

Forgive me for dishonoring you by being sexually impure. Cleanse me and make me holy! Give me the fear of the Lord. Help me to walk softly before you oh God. Deliver me from the idolatry of the female form. Deliver me from unhealthy appetites.

Commandment 8 - Am I stealing -- from You, Lord, or anyone else?

Am I squandering or misusing Your gifts to me? Am I dishonest in my work, taking anything without paying for it or without permission?

Forgive me for poor stewardship, for stealing or squandering time, talents, treasures from you, Lord. Forgive me for my dishonest gains and give me grace to return or restore what I have taken wrongly. Make me a good steward of your temple, my body, and all these things you've given me to manage as a priest in your temple.

Commandment 9 - Am I witnessing falsely?

Forgive me for lying...for telling lies...for speaking exaggerations. Forgive me for being a false witness of Jesus. He is the truth. The devil is a liar. Forgive me for believing false ideas and vain philosophies of men. I want to be a true witness of Jesus Christ. Forgive me for dishonoring You by trusting false things. Today give me the way, the truth, and the life in Jesus Christ!

Commandment 10 – Am I coveting?

Am I coveting things you don't want me to have —my neighbor's house, car, reputation, wife, children, lifestyle? Covetousness is the first sin — the downfall of Eve and Adam that caused their disobedience. Am I coveting anything? My American lifestyle? All blessings are from the Lord. I am grateful for my (spouse), my home, my career, my children.

All abundance is from You, Lord. You are the source of all blessings and abundance. Forgive me for dishonoring you by wanting anything outside of your will for me. God, you are a good God – an abundant God. You have a desire to bless me more than I do! I release my time, I release my money so you can make open space in my life. I want to receive your abundance and blessing! Your will be done. Make open spaces in my life and in my schedule so I may serve you.

All this is possible through the cross and the blood of Jesus Christ. I worship Jesus at the Laver in the Courtyard of the Tabernacle.

River of life .... flow... from the perfect temple in heaven....down the Holy mountain....into our city... the city of our god. Make us glad from your living waters. The waters from holy fountain of heaven.. flow river flow... make glad the city of our God..... God our Father... give us your living water. Give us your heart of love .

## Station 4 - RECEIVE LIGHT AT THE LAMPSTAND READ

I open the curtain and walk into the Holy Place. There I see the candlesticks the only source of light in the Holy place. The lampstand is symbolic of the Holy Spirit operating through your church as the sevenfold Spirit of God: wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, knowledge, fear of the Lord, holiness. It is Holy Spirit who "illuminates" the Word so our mind can see it. But Holy Spirit is not just a light or revelation. He is a Holy person who gives us these things. He is the third person of the Trinity. He is God!

#### **PRAY**

Holy Spirit, I welcome a deeper more intimate relationship with you today. Dear Holy Spirit, through your anointing give me your wisdom. Help me to solve all the problems I face through your wisdom.

Give me your understanding so that I may understand the deep truths of God, and I may live those truths and pass them on to my children.

Give me counsel so that I will follow your narrow path. If it pleases you, allow me to advise others how to solve their problems.

Give me tremendous might, Holy Ghost DUNAMIS power so that I might be used by you to heal the sick and cast out the devil, do miracles, and exercise any of the spiritual gifts you want me to today. You are a supernatural God. I am your child. You give your children spiritual gifts. You are the same yesterday, today, and forever. I receive my spiritual gifts today!

Holy Spirit, increase my knowledge of the Bible. Give me a keen fear of the Lord so that I walk very softly before you and not commit any sin. Give me holiness though your presence, O Lord!

Holy Spirit you are a person, not a genie. The Father worked in the forefront during the Old Testament and Jesus worked on earth in the New Testament; Then Jesus went away so that you could come. Today I live in the Age of the Holy Spirit. You are God in me.

*I want to depend on you, Holy Spirit, not my own strength.* John 14:20 says you are in me! That's where you live. Make yourself very real to me today!

You are not a mist, a genie, or a force. You are a Holy Person. You are HOLY Spirit. God, with a will, and emotions. Forgive me for treating you impersonally. You should be welcomed, loved, caressed, adored, worshipped. You are my senior partner, you are my Lord. I depend upon you. Let's go, Holy Spirit. Thank you for your anointing. Let's work together. I will follow you.

## Station 5 - THE TABLE OF SHOWBREAD

#### **READ**

The Table of Showbread is the place where we honor the Word of God. The bread of the presence, as it's called in the Bible, represents the presence of Jesus, the bread that came down from heaven. Here we commune with the living Word, Jesus. Here we can take communion to eat of his body and drink of his blood.

#### **PRAY**

Thank you for your *logos* word and your *Rehma* word. Thank you for the written word and the inspired Word of God. All the 7,000+ promises of God are written in your Holy scriptures.

The logos written word is potentially mine, but not necessarily practically mine today. Rehma is your inspired word made alive in my heart today for a specific application.

Give me my Lord, your specific word – your Rehma Word – for my life today. Give me this day my daily bread.

Peter never walked on water by reading about the Israelites crossing the Red Sea. He requested Jesus to command him to walk on the water.

"And Peter answered Him, Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water." And Jesus, you did that one time.

A specific Rehma word came directly from the Lord to Peter for a specific situation. He heard, faith came to Peter and just to Peter, by hearing – hearing the Rehma Word from the Lord Jesus to his specific request.

The other disciples did not respond; the Rehma word was not for them. Jesus did not call them to walk on the water. They didn't have the faith or necessarily the desire to do that which Peter did at that moment. Even Peter's faith wavered as he saw himself miraculously walking on the water. (Mat 14:28)

As his faith in that Rhema Word wavered, he became as a wave driven and tossed by the sea – double minded, lacking in faith – and he sank. As he cried out, Jesus, you saved him and brought him into the boat. And so that miracle was over for that specific time.

Peter did not step out of the boat by the written word but by the specific spoken word of the Lord he heard. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Rehma Word of God.

So I must wait on you, Lord, today – if I want to get your inspired Word.

Knowledge can become a kind of false faith. I want true faith from you today, Lord! Operating on knowledge only, can be disobeying you. I want to obey you in all things today.

Naming and claiming promises my finger lands on in scripture is a dangerous business. Waiting on you, Lord, for Rehma is the way of the mature disciple.

Jesus, you spoke of this truth when you said: Man does not live by bread alone but by every word that comes from the MOUTH of God. (Mat 4:4)

### Station 6 - THE ALTAR OF INCENSE

Father, you are omnipotent. You can do anything and I will believe you. Give me perfect faith in Jesus Christ.

I CHOOSE you by exercising my free will today. I choose to believe YOU! I reject fear and doubt About you. What you say in your word is true. Men are prone to lies and exaggerations. You are the way, the truth, and the life.

I trust you. I trust your Word. I trust you, Holy Spirit teach me how to praise you and make intercession at the Altar of Incense.

Here at the Altar of Incense we often stand for several minutes and simply praise God by singing in the Spirit or praying as the Lord leads.. Here you can intercede for others needs. And pray for your family, the lost, the nation, and the world.

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## Praying the Temple Prayer with Pastor Cho

Station 6. THE HOLY OF HOLIES - ARK OF THE COVENANT

I enter with faith and confidence into the Holy of Holies. I see the blood of Jesus Christ sprinkled on the Mercy seat. It is finished. Tatalistai! All my debts have been paid off – paid in full. I am a free man, free from bondage to sin of any kind.

Through the Blood I have the impartation of the righteousness of Jesus Christ! I am God's righteousness in Christ. I come into the presence of God without feeling any

condemnation because of what Christ has already accomplished for me.

The blood is the answer – it is the final solution for me.

I praise you, Father, for the wonderful, incredible blessing of righteousness imparted to me, your servant, through your Son, Jesus Christ.

Thank you, Lord, that the devil is my defeated enemy through the Blood of Christ. I will not bow to the fear of the roaring lion. He is bluffing and he is defeated.

#### The Commandments in the Ark

Christ's blood annuls the power of the law that would make me work for righteousness. The law is my mirror now, not my master. It helps me to clean my face, my conscience. The law does not condemn me.

Christ is my Lord. His blood is the final, finished work that redeems me. The law shows me how to please God and helps me understand when I have grieved and disobeyed God – but it is not my condemner. The blood has changed that forever for me as a New Testament Christian.

No human works or achievements are required for my salvation. Only to believe – only faith in the finished work of the Cross.

Thank you, Father, that the blood is my deliverance from sin. The blood is my impartation of Christ's righteousness. The blood brings my freedom from fear of Satan. The blood is my freedom from the law of the Old Testament. The blood is my freedom from human works to achieve right standing with you, O Lord!

Eph 2:8-10 For it is by free grace [God's unmerited favor] that you are saved through [your] faith. And this [salvation] is not of your own doing, it is the gift of God; it is not because of works [the fulfillment of the Law's demands], lest any man should boast.

## Praying the Temple Prayer with Pastor Cho

For we are God's own workmanship, recreated in Christ Jesus that we may do those good works which God planned beforehand for us, that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].

#### Ripple Prayer

In the Holy of Holies, I pray my own personal requests through what Dr. Cho calls the ripple prayer. I pray for those closest to me and work out from there like a stone making a ripple on the water.

Now I am truly ready to have my prayers answered and my petitions heard. I bring them humbly before the Lord with faith and confidence that he hears me and will answer my prayers.

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
