

### **Performance Dates & Times**

Dress Rehearsal Day: Wednesday September 3 during the school day

Show dates: Wednesday September 3 and Thursday September 4 in the evening at 7PM

**Venue**: Mount Lilydale Mercy College – Centennial Hall

Prep students will be involved in both performances. However, each student in Prep will perform on just **ONE** of the nights. Information about what night each student will perform will be provided early next term.

## **Student Involvement**

All students in Prep will be performing in the ensemble/chorus on one night where they will be on stage for a few musical numbers.

Grade 3-6 students will also be involved with a separate handbook created with their information.

## Rehearsals

From later in Term 2, students will rehearse their musical numbers during their Performing Arts classes. Students may also rehearse with their classroom teacher at other times. Closer to the performance dates, students will rehearse with the rest of their year level as we run the show in full.

## **Costumes**

Costumes are chosen to reflect the style of the show while ensuring students feel

comfortable and confident on stage. Our Prep students will be wearing costumes as part of the school production. We'll be asking families to help provide costume items for their child.

#### Guide sent home:

We kindly ask that you help your child put together a simple costume based around what they would like to be when they grow up/any adult job which can be represented with a costume. There is no need to buy anything new unless you want to. Feel free to get creative with what you already have at home or borrow items from family and friends. With book week also coming up this term, it could be an opportunity to double up the costume with this. Here are some simple costume ideas:

- **Doctor/Nurse:** White shirt, toy stethoscope, and a name badge
- Chef: Apron, wooden spoon, and a chef's hat
- Builder: Flannel shirt, tool belt, and a hard hat
- Artist: Old shirt as a smock and a paint brush in a pocket
- Firefighter/Police Officer: Dark pants, shirt, and toy badge or helmet
- Hairdresser: Hairbrush, spray bottle, apron
- Musician: Band shirt, toy instrument, sunglasses on head
- **Dancer:** Leotard, tutu, or dance outfit
- Scientist: Lab coat, goggles
- Veterinarian: Lab coat, toy animal in pocket
- Farmer: Overalls, gumboots, straw hat, toy animal or produce in pocket
- Pilot: Shirt, tie, captains hat, plane badge

If your child isn't sure what they want to be yet, that's okay! Just choose something fun that they're interested in right now.

When choosing a costume, please keep in mind that student's hands need to be free to perform, so a pocket to place any item related to their chosen job would be ideal. They also need to be able to move freely and safely so please ensure the costume doesn't present as a trip hazard.

#### Hair

Students are asked to arrive at the performances with their hair styled so that it is neat and off their face so we can see them clearly.

## **Production Levy**

To support the costs involved in putting on the show, a production levy will apply. This levy helps cover essential elements such as:

- Bus transport to and from Mount Lilydale Mercy College for the dress rehearsal
- Sets, lighting and props
- Theatre hire, licensing fees, and technical equipment

The production levy and excursion permission is now available on Sentral. The cost is \$25. We kindly ask families to provide permission as soon as possible to help us with planning. Payment isn't due until 22nd August.

#### **School Savings Bonus Reminder:**

Families who wish to use their School Savings Bonus towards the production levy are encouraged to log in to the SSB portal before 30 June 2025 and allocate funds to "Activities." After this date, any unallocated SSB funds will be transferred as a general credit to family accounts—but this transfer may take 4–6 weeks, making them temporarily unavailable in early Term 3. Please also email the office to confirm that you would like the allocated 'Activities' amount to go towards the production levy.

#### **Tickets**

Tickets for our school production of *Matilda Jr.* will go on sale on Monday 4<sup>th</sup>August at 7:00pm.

#### **How to Book Tickets**

Tickets will be available via <a href="https://www.trybooking.com/DDHDN">https://www.trybooking.com/DDHDN</a> from 7:00pm on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> August. We encourage families to book early so as not to miss out. There are two levels of seating: Stalls/Lower and Balcony/Upper.

Please note: Bookings are final and non-refundable, so we recommend checking the cast list and your availability carefully before purchasing.

#### **Being Community Conscious**

To ensure everyone has a fair chance to attend, we ask families to be community conscious in their bookings. If seats were evenly shared, it would allow for around 4-5 tickets per student. Whilst this is not a hard limit, we kindly ask that families keep this in mind during the first week of ticket sales to help ensure every child has someone there to cheer them on. We understand that some families may need fewer tickets, and others more. We trust that our community will book with fairness in mind.

#### **Accessibility**

There are a number of accessible seating options available on the lower (stalls) level, marked with the accessibility symbol when booking. These are ideal for those using wheelchairs or other mobility devices. If you require accessible seats and they have already been sold and are no longer showing as available, please contact the school. If anyone in your booking group requires additional accessibility support, please contact the school prior to booking so we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

## **Dress Rehearsal Day**

All students involved with the production will attend a dress rehearsal day on Wednesday September 3 at the theatre at Mount Lilydale Mercy College. This will help students feel comfortable with the performance space, lighting, sound and backstage area as we complete a full run of the show. Students will catch a bus from WPPS to the venue.

This will be a big day for students, as it includes both the dress rehearsal and the evening performance. To support their wellbeing, we will structure the day with regular breaks for snacks, lunch, and rest, ensuring students are able to manage their energy levels. After the rehearsal, students will go home for a rest and a chance to eat before returning in the evening.

#### **Lead Characters**

Some lead characters may be asked to be dropped at the theatre at Mount Lilydale Mercy College early on the dress rehearsal day so they can rehearse on the stage before the other students arrive.

#### Location: Mount Lilydale Mercy College

#### **Bus Information**

- First bus shuttle leaves Wonga Park PS at 9am (Preps, Grade 6, Grade 5/6 Lead Characters, Featured Soloists, Specialist Dancers, some Stage Crew)
- Second bus shuttle leaves Wonga Park PS at 9:40am (Grade 3, Grade 4, all remaining Grade 5s)
- Buses must leave on time.
- All buses will be back at WPPS by approximately 3PM

#### What to Bring

- As previously communicated, please wear your costume to school on this
  day. This will be sent home before the dress rehearsal day. Please wear a
  jacket to cover the costume whilst eating throughout the day.
- Lead Characters will change into their costume at the venue.
- Please pack a backpack which has snacks, lunch, water bottle and quiet card games/colouring books/pencils/activities which students can use in down time. Teachers will also bring some of these things. No iPads or other technology please.
- Plenty of breaks are scheduled for students during the day so they can eat and have some play time.

## **Performance Evenings**

#### Wednesday 3rd September and Thursday 4th September

Location: Mount Lilydale Mercy College

#### **Drop Off**

All students must be signed in to a supervising teacher by an adult. If they are being taken home by another person, please let their classroom teacher know via email or let the teacher know when you drop them off so we can take note.

- Lead Cast: Drop off between 5 and 5:30PM (Leads who require support with hair and makeup, please arrive at 5).
- Featured Soloists and Specialist Dancers: Drop off at 6PM.
- **Prep Chorus/Grade 3-6 Chorus:** Drop off between 6:30PM and 6:45PM.
- The performance begins at 7PM.

#### What to Bring

- All students: Please bring a full drink bottle with water only.
- **Prep Chorus/Grade 3-6 Chorus/Specialist Dancers:** Please arrive in your full costume with hair and makeup (if using) completed.
- **Featured Soloists:** Please arrive in your mum/dad costume.
- **Lead Characters:** Will change into their costume at the theatre.
- Students might like to bring some quiet games/activities to play with whilst they wait. No iPads or other technology please.
- It can get cold in the gym out the back, so we recommend students bring an extra jacket for when they aren't performing.


- Some students might benefit from headphones, earplugs or loops in this space to help dampen the echo in the gym.

#### Pick Up

- At this stage, pick up will be from approximately 8:30pm for *all students*. We will confirm this time at the start of next week once we have run the show a few times and have a more accurate time.
- Pick up after the show is inside the gym (where you dropped them off but inside the building). Students must be signed out by an adult from a supervising teacher.

#### PARKING AND DROP OFF / PICK UP LOCATIONS

- The drop off location is at the entry to the gym. This is located at the back of the theatre. Please see the map below (blue arrow).
- Once lead characters are signed in, the students can come to the dressing room in the theatre (they will have been shown this location on the dress rehearsal day).
- If you are just dropping your child off for the performance and then leaving, please drive to the drop off point and carpark attendants/supervising teachers will assist and direct you to the exit.
- Parking is in the designated areas in the red circles on the map below. Please adhere to all parking signs and instructions from parking attendants to help manage the traffic flow and other users of the school.



## **Production T-Shirt**

We're excited to offer a special *Matilda Jr.* t-shirt for students involved in this year's production! These t-shirts are a fun keepsake and a great way for students to feel part of the cast and proud of their contribution.

T-shirts are **not** compulsory, but students may enjoy having one to wear during rehearsals, for some of Term Three on special production days, and as a reminder of this exciting experience.
