- OUT Maine Scholarship: The OUT Maine Scholarship Fund provides renewable support for Maine LGBTQ+ youth pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited, not-for-profit, non-sectarian college, university, or technical/vocational college in the United States. Applicants must demonstrate a financial need. Scholarships are varied in size from \$1,000 to \$25,000 annually, depending on a student's financial need and application. The applicant may be asked to meet with a representative of OUT Maine to discuss the application.
- Middle School Dance: There will be a semi-formal Middle School Dance on March 22nd 6-9pm in the cafeteria. Students will need to sign up prior to the dance in the Main Office.
