  - Picnic-style Bingo Bring your own blanket or chairs to enjoy Bingo on the basketball courts behind the school

  - o Tickets \$2 CASH, CHECK, MEMBERHUB
  - \*\*\* We emailed all the families who paid cash/check and told them we received their payment! Next year we should explain that we aren't sending out actual tickets but that their payment reserves their spot and checking in gets them their bingo stuff and food.

  - For flyer: Put in all kids folders on 3/9 and return by 3/29

- Reminder: All children must be accompanied by an adult. This is not a drop-off event.
- Check box: I would like to volunteer for a portion of the event to help with check-in, the prize table, writing bingo numbers, etc. (phrase however you think). Then once we have a count of how many want to help we can figure out if we need more. Rather than doing a sign up genius we decided to create a list of jobs we need and assign them as people arrive.
- (In 2022: We had 320 people total purchase tickets! 78 pizzas, 23 salads.)
- In 2023, we had 423 people total purchase tickets. 86 pizzas, 14 salads
- Pizza available for pre-order
  - Coordinate with Vocelli's (410-313-8774) Sudip is the manager
    - Price from Vocelli's: Large 14 inch cheese \$9, large 14 inch pep \$9.50, salad
       \$8.75
    - PTA charged (in 2023): Cheese \$9.50, Pep \$10, Salad \$9
    - Arrange for the order based on the number of pre-orders
      - \$2.50 per delivery (plus tip) or we can pick up for free
        - We had it delivered in 2023
      - 1 week notice
    - Add a few extra pizzas for teachers & custodians
    - Vocelli's can provide plates and napkins they did not provide enough so ask for more!
      - They will also leave the warmers and we return them later
    - Mix of dressings on the side
  - o In 2022 we had 320 people total purchase tickets. 78 pizzas, 23 salads.
  - o In 2023, we had 423 people total purchase tickets. 86 pizzas, 14 salads
  - Orders must be submitted at least 1 week prior to event
- Budget to hold event: For 2023 it's \$738
  - o **1 2023 Bingo expenses**
- Supplies
  - New Bingo Set In PTA closet (E6)
    - There also might still be an old set in there that is missing a ball. Should probably get rid of that set so it doesn't accidentally get used.
  - Microphone and speaker In PTA closet check ahead of time how to set up
    - Ms. Foster offered that we can use her speakers she came at the end and cleaned them up!
  - Extension cord the school had one that Mrs. Foster and Linda used to set up speakers
  - Registration list Meg created sheet with Memberhub file and Jane manually entered paper flier/cash/check orders \*\*\*PRINT 6 of these FOR TABLES at sign in. Having just one of these made check in tricky so have 6 check in people and 2-4 people to give pizzas and salads and bingo/snack bags

- Bingo Cards currently have 120 packs of 25 sheets, 216 packs of 15 sheets, and 457 packs of 15 each that are already cut and stapled
- In 2022, Jane purchased a box of 400 crayons for the event for kids to use to mark off bingo numbers. Still plenty to use for 2023
- o To Buy:
  - Brown paper bags to put each person's bingo supplies and food in
  - Chip Bags
  - Candy
  - Water
  - Prizes
- Prizes & Tablecloth (jane has one)
  - We have 56ish prizes. We will have 2 prize tables (<u>table #1</u> bigger/pick 1 prizes and <u>table #2</u> smaller/pick 2 prizes). 26 pick 1 and 31 pick 2 (so 41 winners total)
  - We added 25 gift cards because we had 420+ people! We had to add x5 SPOTOGRAMS at the end because of all the winners!
- First aid kit from closet
- Trash Can (from school) maybe we need 5 of them given how many people? Pizza boxes make for LOTS of trash. Paul asked us to put pizza boxes in the recycle bins and we had carts to put them on as well.
- o Tables (from school) 12 total

The event starts at 6pm. After everyone arrives and gets settled, bingo games will be from 6:30pm-8:00 pm. During that time frame, we'll have 3, 30 minute rotations of 4 volunteers for the 4 jobs listed below. When it is time to switch, we will call out your names and you can come to me and I'll let you know where we need help.

**Bingo number writer** - This person will write the Bingo numbers on a white board as they are called. When a player calls that they have Bingo, the player will go up front to the teachers table to check their numbers and this board can be a helpful reference.

**Prize table attendant** - This person can show the winners their prize options and remind them of their options. Bingo winners can choose to pick one prize from the big prize table or two prizes from the small prize table.

**Door monitor** - Since we have access to the SJLES bathrooms, we will need someone to stand at the SJLES back door near Mrs. Peddicord's art room to monitor people going in and coming

out. We want to remind kids that they can just use the bathroom and come right back out to bingo!

  - Registration list Meg created sheet with Memberhub file and Jane manually entered paper flier/cash/check orders \*\*\*PRINT this FOR TABLE at sign in. Having just one of these made check in tricky so we thought it would be better to split the alphabetized list down the middle and have A-L on one side and M-Z on the other (or whatever split makes sense)

- Bingo Cards currently have 120 packs of 25 sheets, 216 packs of 15 sheets, and 457 packs of 15 each that are already cut and stapled
  - Ask Andrea Muirhead how many Bingo Games are usually played: 7 to 10 games but with more people we may have winners shouting bingo quicker and there will be more multiple winners so we got more prizes to account for this! Left over prizes will go to May Day fun!
- Stampers? currently have 39 stampers will add 9 of them as prize options and the other 30 we will offer as a prize for the first 30 bingo players who arrive on bingo night!
   We used all of these!
- Jane purchased box of 400 crayons for the event for kids to use to mark off bingo numbers

- Prizes
  - Ask Andrea Muirhead how many prizes we should need: for 170ish people
    Andrea said 15 to 20 prizes so we more than doubled it to 50+ prizes for 300ish
    people. Some prizes are smaller so kids can pick 2 of those and then for the
    bigger prizes they can pick 1. We will have 2 prize tables (table #1 bigger/pick 1
    prizes and table #2 smaller/pick 2 prizes). We decided to keep it the same as
    2019, so all games are created equally kids who win any bingo game can pick
    from one of the two tables. We didn't have prizes left at the end because
    someone told the kids it was ok to storm the prize table:)
