#### 24/17 Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting - 17<sup>th</sup> June 2024 were read and accepted as a true record, subject to a correction on attendance **P** - HJ, **S** - AS.

### **Matters Arising**

- 20/29 Storyboard: In hand with HJ. [ON HOLD]
- 21/04 Football Club Lease: No further signed copies available, disappointing to note that some previous correspondence on the matter has reportedly been shredded. HJ noted that such documents should be preserved. [CLOSE]
- 23/20&71 Road Safety Issues: SJ to chase PCC re covers at the Square and line painting at Craig Las. [ONGOING]
- 21/88 Community Garden: It was sad to note that approx 10 trees had been deliberately vandalised. Residents should be encouraged to take photos if they see any such behaviour and report it. [ONGOING]
- 22/12 Trees: Waiting for the weather to improve. [ONGOING]
- 22/15 Picnic Benches: On hold at present [ON HOLD]
- 23/06 Ground Haverfordwest Road: Land Registry claim ongoing. [ONGOING]
- 23/27 Toilets: In hand [ONGOING]
- 23/80 Carnival: Noted that the Carnival went very well on the day, with thanks to all those who helped, particularly the Hall Committee. [CLOSE]
- 24/06 Bus Stop clock: BM noted that the clock will have to come out during the winter due to the wooden housing being rotten.. [CLOSE]
- 24/13 Fireworks: RD stated that the cost will be roughly the same as last year. P HJ, S AS and carried that we go ahead. We will need to promote the event in September and ask for volunteers to assist. [ONGOING]
- **24/14 Memorial Parade:** SJ to write to G Eynon to confirm availability. RD suggested that a tree impinging on the memorial needs to be removed and the surrounding wall may require painting. [ONGOING]
- 24/15 Playpark: It was noted that the grass has been cut. BH will ask the contractor if he
  requires a chain and sign. Replacements for worn seats have been ordered from
  Kompan and will be warranty claims at no charge [ONGOING]
- **24/16 Potholes:** AS noted that some potholes in St Davids Road were fixed when the road was temporarily closed.

#### 24/21 PCC Report

MB updated that a School Reorganisation report was due out soon with some projections for pupil numbers at various schools.

A new LDP consultation is due to come out in the autumn.

Boundary Commission recommendations had been published with recommendations that among others, Wolfscastle combines with Hayscastle. There will also be changes to councillor numbers. Letterston is unaffected.

A consultation is also being published on re-tendering for the T5 Haverfordwest - Aberystwyth bus route.

#### 24/22 New Items

 24/23 School Prize: HJ reported that she had not received a reply to her request for a name for the School Prize.

- **24/24 Footpath:** HJ has received complaints that the footpath from the bottom of St Davids Road towards Highfield was subject of persistent dog fouling and also did not have a sign off the highway.
- 24/25 Old Toilet Block: HJ asked that painting the old block at the Commons be raised at the next meeting.
- **24/26 Battery Scooters:** RD noted that these were becoming a nuisance on most roads in the village. SJ to ask PCSO to pay passing attention. [ONGOING].
- **24/27 Maintenance:** AS asked if LCC could consider a policy to appoint local contractors for various maintenance jobs, thus keeping money within the community. [ONGOING]
- 24/28 Prizes: AS asked if a donation could be made towards five horse riding prizes for local disabled children. P RD £5 each, S LA.
- **24/29 Water Supply:** GH noted that parts of Min y Llan had suffered loss of water pressure since last November, with some unable to take showers. [ONGOING]
