**MOORESVILLE GRADED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION
Board Regular Meeting Minutes, Tuesday, May 5, 2026, 6:00 p.m.**

The Board of Education of the Mooresville Graded School District met in a Board Business Meeting on Tuesday, May 5, 2026, at the Mooresville Town Hall, 413 N. Main St., Mooresville, NC 28115.

Board Members Present: Greg Whitfield, Board Chair; Rakeem Brawley, Vice Chair; Monica Bender; Dr. Debbie Marsh; and, Kerry Pennell.

Call to Order: Mr. Whitfield, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:00pm and called for a moment of silence before reflecting on the work teachers do to spark curiosity and inspire lifelong learning. Dr. Gardner then invited Taitlyn Lanning, the Student of the Month, to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Agenda: On a motion by Debbie Marsh, seconded by Monica Bender, the board voted 5-0 to approve the meeting agenda as presented.

Approval of the Minutes: On a motion by Monica Bender, seconded by Kerry Pennell, the board voted 5-0 to approve the minutes from the April 7, 2026 meeting as presented.

Student of the Month: The School Board recognized Mooresville Middle School student, Taitlyn Lanning, as the Student of the Month for May 2026. Dr. Gardner shared the reasons Taitlyn was selected as listed on the nomination form.

Artist of the Month: The School Board then recognized and presented the Artist of the Month Award for May 2026 to Nayyir Reed, student at Mooresville Middle School. Dr. Gardner shared the reasons the student was selected as listed on the nomination form, and Nayyir performed for the Board.

ABCD Award: The School Board recognized and presented the May 2026 Above and Beyond the Call of Duty Award to Ms. Lori Denzel, EC Teacher Assistant/Athletic First Responder at Mooresville Middle School. Ms. Denzel was nominated by the Mooresville Middle School Instructional Team for demonstrating the MGSD Core Values of Authentic Relationships, Integrity and Safety.

Spotlight on People: The School Board recognized East Mooresville Intermediate School student, Leila Tomosovitch, for her student-designed birthday card artwork. Students from across the district were invited to submit their original artwork for the district's birthday card design. Leila's design was selected to be featured on the official 2026-27 MGSD staff birthday card. The Board extended its appreciation to Leila for her creativity and for representing the artistic talent present within the student body.

The School Board also recognized Mooresville Police Department K9 Officer Bella for her years of dedicated service to MGSD. At nine years old, Officer Bella is officially retiring following a distinguished career of service to students and staff. The Board extended its sincere gratitude to Bella and her handler, Sergeant Walther, for their unwavering dedication to the MGSD community and their commitment to maintaining a safe, welcoming environment throughout Mooresville's schools.

School Highlights: Mooresville Middle School Principal, Patrick Kosal, Assistant Principal, Ron Bost, and Media Coordinator, Jackie McAllister, presented an overview of their initiatives focused on recognizing

students who embody the "HEART" of an MMS Red Imp: Honorable, Engaged, Accountable, Responsible, and Tolerant. The leadership team detailed the success of their grade-level character lunches, an initiative where students demonstrating exceptional character are invited to bring a peer to a catered meal with Principal Kosal. These sessions serve as a collaborative forum for students to share feedback on the school climate, including both current successes and areas for growth. The MMS team emphasized the school's commitment to student voice, noting that the administration is actively working to implement the suggestions gathered during these discussions.

Staff Reports:

- **Maximize Opportunity & Achievement:** Jonathan Ribbeck, Chief of Schools, shared:
 - Fifth-grade students at the intermediate schools recently presented their Gateway Projects on famous inventors. Recognition was given to the students for their research and to the teachers for their instructional support and preparation.
 - The Multilingual Learner (ML) Celebration and Picnic was held on April 24. The event was well-attended by families and featured food and games. Special thanks were extended to Dr. Waid and the ML staff for coordinating the celebration of student accomplishments.
 - The 2nd Semester AIG Advisory Meeting took place on April 27. The team reviewed progress on Annual SMART Goals, discussed K-2 identification pathways, and reviewed the benefits of universal 2nd-grade screening. Recognition was given to Ms. Conley, Dr. Waid, Ms. Smith, and Ms. Fitzsimmons for their leadership.
 - In honor of Principal Appreciation Day on May 1, the district recognized the dedication of Dr. Rogers, Ms. Kaemba, Ms. Dortch, Dr. Cottone, Ms. Pratt-Dixon, Mr. Kosal, Mr. Miller, Ms. Graham, and Ms. Allen.
 - The district expressed gratitude to all educators during National Teacher Appreciation Week for their continued service to students, families, and the school community.
 - MHS will host the annual E3 event on May 8 to celebrate seniors who are Enrolled, Enlisted, or Employed. Additionally, the Class of 2026 graduation ceremony is scheduled for May 23 at 8:30 a.m. in Coach Joe Popp Stadium.
 - End-of-Year (EOY) testing will occur over the coming weeks. Parents are encouraged to ensure students receive adequate rest and arrive prepared to perform their best.
 - Enrollment remains open for the upcoming school year. Families are urged to complete registration promptly to assist the district in finalizing staffing, classroom allocations, and resource planning.

- **Safe, Happy, and Healthy:** Dr. Michael Royal, Chief Operations Officer and Dr. Sandra Albert presented updates on the Safe, Happy, and Healthy strategic initiative:
 - Several teams were recognized for recent postseason successes including SBMS Girls Track & Field and MMS Boys Track & Field, MMS Girls Soccer, and MHS Track & Field .
 - In honor of School Nutrition Employee Appreciation Day on May 1, Ms. Staci Burchfield and individual school sites hosted celebrations, including an ice cream social.
 - Families are reminded to submit bus transportation requests for the upcoming school year via ParentSquare. Requests must be resubmitted annually to ensure accurate routing.
 - The annual bus driver cookout will take place next week. The district extends its gratitude to "Shop N Save" for their generous donation of food for the event.
 - The annual Operations Luncheon and Awards ceremony to honor and recognize operations employees is scheduled for Friday, May 22, in the PAC.
 - All schools have finalized training on state and district-level Behavioral Threat Assessment processes. Implementation will continue at the building level through MTSS teams, administrators, SROs, and counselors.

- A review of two-year data indicates a decrease in aggressive behavior but an increase in inappropriate conduct referrals. The district remains committed to restorative practices and reflective In-School Suspension to maintain an educational focus on discipline.
- **Recruit, Grow, and Retain:** April Kuhn, Chief Human Resource Officer and Angela Davis, Chief Financial Officer presented the updates:
 - Following college visits and the MGSD Career Fair, the district conducted school tours for prospective teachers. Collaborative efforts with school sites are ongoing to finalize hires and secure new talent for the upcoming year.
 - As part of district-wide retention efforts, a spring BT Celebration was held at Performance Coffee. The event provided beginning teachers an opportunity to network and connect with colleagues across the district.
 - The district will host a Retiree Celebration next week to honor and fellowship with staff members who have concluded their years of service to MGSD.
 - Recommendations for teacher and administrator contract renewals (1, 2, or 4-year terms) are being presented to the Board this month. Additionally, licensure renewal notices have been distributed to staff, with processing underway to meet the state's June 30 deadline.
 - The district received an extensive response to the invitation for bids for copier and printing services by the April 17 deadline. The copier committee is currently scoring vendors, and a recommendation will be brought to the Board in June.
 - Finance and Operations have partnered with P3 Cost Analysts to identify savings in utilities, waste, water, and telecommunications. A full report on identified cost savings will be presented to the Board upon completion of the audit.
 - Members of the Finance Department attended the Region 7 "job alike" meeting on April 22. Discussions included upcoming State Health Plan changes, employer reporting requirements, and the current RFP for a third-party provider for 2028. State Health Plan representatives will continue to seek feedback from districts during future regional meetings.
- **Culture of Relationships:** Tanae McLean, Chief Communications Officer presented updates:
 - The district hosted a successful Oregon Trail event in Downtown Mooresville. Appreciation was expressed to Amy Smith and the assisting district staff for coordinating the interactive stations. Parents provided positive feedback.
 - The district will host an informational table during Mooresville Day on Saturday 5/9/26, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Community members are encouraged to visit with questions. The PVES Patriot (Ms. Angie) is also scheduled to appear.
 - Wednesday, May 6, marks School Nurse Appreciation Day. The district recognized its eight staff nurses for their essential contributions, including first responder training, immunization compliance, medication administration, and emergency response. It was noted that district nurses managed over 23,000 office visits in the previous year.
- **Superintendent Comments:** Dr. Gardner shared that he was recently appointed to the Governor's Blue Ribbon Commission, a bipartisan group tasked with developing recommendations for statewide education reform. The commission includes stakeholders from K-12, higher education, the business sector, and the General Assembly.
 - The initial meeting focused on establishing expectations and discussing both the strengths of the current educational system and necessary areas for improvement. A key point of discussion involved the declining likelihood of parents encouraging their children to enter the teaching profession.
 - Dr. Gardner emphasized that high-quality teachers are the primary predictor of student academic success and that state-level reform should focus on making education a more desirable career path.
 - In observance of Teacher Appreciation Week, Dr. Gardner concluded by urging continued advocacy for reforms that honor and support the work of educators.

- **Board Events:** Chairman Whitfield provided information on several upcoming events including:

Public Comment: There was 1 individual signed up for public comment. Amber Bryant of Mooresville spoke regarding MHS Cheerleading. Public comments concluded at 6:59pm.

Items for Information:

- A. CTE Local Plan:** Kevin Wilson, Career and Technical Education Administrator and Dr. Tracey Waid, Director of Secondary Instruction, presented an initial draft of the CTE local plan for 2026-2028. The plan emphasizes the importance of providing high-quality, relevant instruction that prepares students for both postsecondary education and immediate entry into the workforce. Key components of the strategy include expanding access to work-based learning opportunities and strengthening partnerships with local industries. Mr. Wilson highlighted the use of comprehensive local needs assessments to drive decision-making and resource allocation. Performance indicators such as graduation rates, credential attainment, and post-program placement will be closely monitored to evaluate the effectiveness of the initiatives. The plan also outlines a commitment to continuous professional development for educators and the modernization of classroom equipment to mirror current industry standards. The plan serves as a roadmap for enhancing the district's CTE offerings to better serve students and the broader community over the next 4-Years. This plan will be presented at the June 2, 2026 meeting for approval.
- B. Policy Revision:** Tanae McLean presented a change to BOE policy 1510/4200/7270. This change adds section F: Annual Safety Review which clarifies annual requirements and timelines for student safety drills, training for staff members, as well as training for students on the "See Something, Say Something" reporting platform. Ms. McLean also presented a change to BOE policy 8350. This change increases the threshold for what constitutes a fixed asset from a value of \$5,000 to \$10,000 or more. This recommendation is at the advice of our auditors due to increased inflation. The updated policies will be presented at the June 2, 2026 meeting for approval.

Items for Approval:

- C. Supplemental Tax Rate:** Angie Davis presented the recommendation that MGSD maintain the supplemental tax rate of 15.5 cents per 100 dollar valuation. The current tax rate of 15.5 cents per 100 dollar valuation has not been increased since 2012. **On a motion by Kerry Pennell, seconded by Debbie Marsh, the board voted 5-0 to approve the Supplemental Tax Rate.**
- D. 2026-27 Facility Use Fee Schedule:** As per MGSD Policy 5030: Community Use of Facilities, Dr. Michael Royal recommended that the MGSD facility use fee structure remain the same for 2026-27. **On a motion by Monica Bender, seconded by Rakeem Brawley, the board voted 5-0 to approve the 2026-27 Facility Use Fee Schedule as presented.**
- E. Field Trip:** Jonathan Ribbeck requested approval for 3 MHS students and 2 chaperones to travel to Washington D.C to participate in the FCCLA-CTSO for Family and Consumer Sciences. These 3 students competed and placed high enough to be invited to the National Leadership Conference. The only cost for students will be meals as the remaining costs will be covered utilizing CTE funding. **On a motion by Rakeem Brawley, seconded by Debbie Marsh, the board voted 5-0 to approve the Field Trip as presented.**
- F. 2025-26 Calendar Revision:** Dr. Gardner shared that Friday May 1 was modified from a student day to an optional teacher workday in response to the significant number of staff members taking leave to attend a pro public education event in Raleigh. Despite efforts to cover absences with

substitute teachers, as well as assigning central services employees to substitute, MGSD determined that we would not be able to adequately cover classrooms to ensure a safe and productive environment. No make-up day for students has been scheduled as the district has adequate time built into the calendar to meet all legislative requirements. **On a motion by Debbie Marsh, seconded by Kerry Pennell, the board voted 5-0 to approve the 2025-26 Calendar Revision as presented.**

Closed Session: According to **NC G.S. §143-318.11 subsections (a)(1), (a)(3) & (a)(6)**, Mr. Brawley, Vice Chair, requested the board go into a closed session to prevent the disclosure of information that is not considered public record, review personnel and consult with the board attorney. **On a motion by Rakeem Brawley, seconded by Debbie Marsh, the board voted 5-0 to go into closed session.**
