

Have a College Counseling Question?

Here is your guide for whom to contact:

Students are assigned an individual college counselor at the beginning of the second semester of eleventh grade. Until the student is assigned an individual college counselor, Upper School students have a college counseling contact based upon who is teaching the Future Pathways course.

As college counselors see students in small groups during the Future Pathways course, students are encouraged to ask questions during this time. In Grades 9-10, the Future Pathways course is taught during some Advisory lessons, thus the college counselor contact is grouped by the Advisory teacher. In Grades 11-12, the Future Pathways course is taught every other week and is listed in the student's LMS schedule. Thus, the college counselor to contact is the same as the person listed in the Future Pathways course in a student's schedule.
