- SCIENCE:

- What is **force**?

- A **force** is a push or a pull that makes an object move.

- What is **motion**?

- **Motion** is a change in an object's position.

- Simple Machines:

- A **simple machine** is a tool that can make it easier to move things.

Simple machines help people do work.

- **Pulley**: A rope that moves a wheel.

- It makes it easier to lift heavy objects.

- **Lever**: A bar that balances on a point.

- It makes it easier to move something.

- Examples: An oar or a seesaw.

- **Ramp**: A slanted surface.

- You use it to move things up or down. People sometimes use ramps to move things that are hard to get up stairs.

- Position:

- It is the place where **something is located**.

- Examples: Over, Under, Left, or Right.

- Why do shoes have rough bottoms?

- Shoes have rough bottoms so people won't easily fall over. Without rough bottoms, there will be no **friction**.
