Stuff to Bring

- Water Bottle. You may want to buy and bring a refillable water bottle to carry around during the week.

Stuff NOT to Bring

- Spaghetti strap tops or small tank tops
- "Short" shorts or short short skirts. (Please dress modestly)
- Speedos (Please no speedos. We don't want to lose our lunch)
- Personal music devices (mp3 players, iPods, etc)
- Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or weapons
- Fireworks
- Clothing with questionable sayings, slogans, etc.
- Cell Phones. We will give parents and emergency only number to use in emergencies.
