Cutting Instructions

- Basic White CS: 8-½" x 11"; 5-½" x 4-¼" for stamping the flowers and leaves.
- Flowers & More DSP: (2) 5-½" x 4-¼" ; 6" x 2-¼" for envelope flap

Assembly Instructions

1. Cut the 8-½" x 11" Basic White CS in half so you have two pieces that are 5-½" x 8-½" and score them at 4-¼" so you have two card bases.
2. Glue one piece of the DSP to the front flap of one card base and to the back of the other card base. Be sure to only put glue around the outside

Assembly Instructions Continued

- edges of the DSP so you can use the die cut pieces for another project.
3. Die cut the center out of the front flap with either the Deckled Rectangle dies or the Countryside Corners Dies.
4. To determine placement for the smaller rectangle die, tuck the right side of your card base into the other card base. Close the right flap to the inside and the front flap (that you die cut) over the top of the other card base that has the DSP glued on it.
5. Line up the smaller rectangle in the center of the opening. Separate them and then die cut the small opening.
6. Glue the back of the right flap of the card base with the larger opening to the inside left flap of the card base with the smaller opening.
7. Close your card and then stamp your sentiment at the top of the small opening on the inside of your card.
8. Stamp the flowers and leaves and die cut them.
9. Glue the flowers and leaves on the front flap as shown, then open the top flap and glue flowers and leaves to the right flap. Open the right flap and glue flowers and leaves to the inside as shown..
10. Add your pearls or whatever embellishments you would like.
11. Glue the 5-¾" x 2-¼" piece of DSP to the flap of your envelope and trim around it.

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
