Course Description

This course is designed to help close the gap for special education students performing below grade level expectations. Students in this course will receive targeted instruction and support in Language Arts, Reading, and Writing to help improve their overall reading and writing skills.

Our coursework will be centered around the major literary genres, namely nonfiction, drama, fiction and poetry, and we will write in the major modes of writing (narrative, expository, persuasive and poetry). This course will prepare you to encounter a world that requires all of us to be readers and writers. Just like in the world, being a non-reader and/or a non-writer is not an option.

Course Expectations

Students will follow school and district expectations in the classroom by learning and modeling good citizenship through interactions with the classroom teacher and peers. The following are non-negotiable classroom expectations:

1. **Punctuality** -- Students should be in their seats and working on their bell-ringer when the bell rings. Students should have all materials already ready and do not need to be up and moving about the classroom. *You will be marked tardy if you are not in your seat when the bell rings.*
2. **Preparation** -- Students should bring all materials to class each day, to include: a charged laptop, their consumable textbook, novel, a writing utensil, and/or any work that was assigned.
3. **Participation** -- Students should be active participants in the classroom, asking questions for clarification, and fully engaging with their peers academically.
4. **Procedures** -- Students are expected to know the policies and procedures and follow them appropriately. Students should ask for clarification if they are confused or need further assistance. *All school and CMCSS policies are also applicable to this classroom.*

Behavioral Procedures

First offense: verbal warning and individual conference with the student

Second offense: individual conference with student and parent contact through phone call and/or email

Third offense: written referral and parent contact

Fourth offense: conference with parent, student, teacher, and a member of the administrative team if applicable
