Experience professional art:

- o Check out a Gallery-Art Exhibits, Artist Studios, Art Districts, Museums etc.
- See a live performance- Miners Alley Playhouse, Arvada Center, Denver Center for the Performing Arts etc.
- o Go to a food festival or to a live cooking event where you get to cook along with the chef!
- See a live music performance- Colorado Symphony, Philharmonic, Colorado Chorale etc.

Nurture the art around you

- Attend another art's area event-
 - Check out our calendar for all events, go to events you aren't involved with and enjoy the art created by others

• Reach-out beyond your circle

- o Be a leader, build community
- Offer to help out your fellow students. Seniors: this is a chance for you to mentor a freshman.
 Take a chance and put yourself out there to make a connection with someone that you don't know personally. It is important that we maintain our ensemble and create a safe and fun environment where we can share our art with one another.

• **Involvement** in YOUR Art's events

- Participate in YOUR arts areas events
 - Audition for shows, submit for young masters, tryout for solos, apply to be a technician, join FCCLA etc.
- Do a PAH share. At least once in your first three years.

• Chip in

- Volunteer for PAH events*, you get out of PAH what you put into it
 - Check our sign-up genius
 - *PAH events include the PAH Picnic, Back to School Night, Palooza, PAH Auditions, PAH registration and welcome reception, capstones

• **Have ideas** about what's next

- PAH Annual Check-in
 - Check in with your mentor at the end of each year and set goals and discuss plan for the next year.
- o PAH Enrichment Self Reflection
 - Check in with yourself each semester and fill out the google form

Academic Expectations:

- Must be passing all classes;
- Must maintain an A or B in PAH specific classes:
- Must be enrolled in an Arts class each semester;
- Must uphold the rules and regulations for attendance/behavior/tardy policies
- Complete enrichment expectations
