Sanchez Sr. Memorial Scholarship 2026 -</u> A "Do More" attitude and demonstrate leadership and community affairs, at least 50 community service hours, Minimum 3.0 GPA, US Citizen or Legal Resident, low to moderate income families, Top Ten students of class are not eligible to apply.
- **4.** <u>Communities In Schools IS LULAC #7/#624/Laredo Daybreak</u>-Must be U.S. citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 300 words), essay must have student signature.

- **5.** <u>Doctors Hospital of Laredo (Gift Shop)</u>- Medical field, economic status, GPA, STAAR scores, school and health community involvement will be considered, ACT or SAT scores, 2 letters of recommendation.

Sanchez Sr. Memorial Scholarship 2026</u>- A "Do More" attitude and demonstrate leadership and community affairs, at least 50 community service hours, Minimum 3.0 GPA, US Citizen or Legal Resident, low to moderate income families, Top Ten students of class are not eligible to apply.

- **12.** <u>LULAC #12</u>-Must be U.S. citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 300 words), essay must have student signature.

- **17.** <u>The Area Health Education Center (AHEC) LULAC</u>-Must be U.S. citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 300 words), essay must have student signature.
- **18.** <u>The Laredo A&M Mother's Club</u> Mother <u>must</u> become an active member of the club, student needs to be accepted to Texas A&M University, College Station, needs acceptance letter.
- **19.** <u>The Laredo Daybreak Rotary Club</u>- graduating high school student for the 2025 2026 scholastic year. Have applied to or been accepted to a college/university, application must be handwritten, fill out all sections/questions on the attached application.
- **20.** <u>Vidal M. Trevino Ed. Foundation</u>-Graduating High School student exceeding an 87.5 GPA and a SAT score exceeding 950, or a minimum ACT score of 18. Family adjusted gross income should not exceed \$85,000.00 a year. However, a \$5,000.00 extra allowance will be added for every sibling already in college. Applicants will be required to submit a copy of their family's 2024 income tax return to verify adjusted gross income. Failure to do so will disqualify them.
- **21.** Webb County Better Community Foundation /Isidro Alaniz Scholarship College bound students with high achievements in academics and athletics as well as community involvement. Complete application along with a resume or essay.
- **22.** <u>Webb County FARM Bureau 2026 College Scholarship</u> Parents or grandparents must be members of the Webb County FARM Bureau for 1 year prior, must be accepted to a college or university for fall of 2026.

- **23.** <u>Webb County LULAC #22387-</u>Must be U.S. citizen or legal resident, community involvement, leadership activities, good grades, ACT or SAT scores, letter of acceptance from college/university, personal essay (no more than 300 words), essay must have student signature.
- **24.** <u>Webb County Policy Council Head Start</u>-Former head-start enrollee (proof required), at least 2.0 GPA (attach an official transcript), need copy of income tax return, personal goal statement (200 words or less), list of all scholarships received with dates awarded.
