Be Respectful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain voice level "1" when a presenter is speaking • Actively listen to the presentation • Sit in your grade-designated area • Use appropriate language • Celebrate the success of others with appropriate applause and/or cheering 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a voice level of "2" or lower • Keep books organized on the shelves while you look • Make sure materials checked out to you do not get damaged • Promptly return books you have finished reading 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a voice level of "3" or lower • Follow instructions of the bus driver • Face forward in your seat • Keep the aisle clear 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Think before you speak or type • Share the space; give others a chance to speak • Use proper grammar, spelling, capitalization, and punctuation • Attempt to find the answer before requesting help • Use your name when signing into programs • Mute yourself when not speaking • Ask permission before making changes to group work • Use headphones for programs that require sound
Be Responsible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave all belongings in your locker during an assembly • Actively participate in the activities • Encourage the speaker and participants • Be a good role model to those around you 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you look at a book and decide you don't want to check it out, put it back in the right spot • When checking out a book, line up along the desk and wait patiently • Check out no more than two books and one magazine at a time • Renew or return books that are overdue • Report any issues with materials to staff 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wait patiently for the bus to come to a complete stop before boarding • Make sure to take all of your personal belongings with you when exiting • Use the wastebasket in the bus to dispose of any trash 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have all materials needed to complete work • Remove distractions • Stay on websites chosen by the teacher • Turn in assignments on time • Participate in online discussions and live class sessions • Keep personal information private (logins, passwords, etc.) • Report unsafe or bullying comments • Only open emails from people you know • Avoid and report inappropriate sites
