Q: What's the difference between being a student aide and being an Applied Educational Leadership Intern?

A: Whereas student aides help the **teacher** with data-keeping, organization, etc., Applied Educational Leadership Interns help the **students** with understanding and completing their work in class.

Q: Will I receive SSL Hours as an Applied Educational Leadership Intern?

A: No, you will not receive SSL Hours, you will earn elective course credit
