Mention only specific concepts (words or phrases), 3-5 concepts, truly conceptual words, and not too general, in italics. Keywords should be sorted alphabetically..

Abstract

The abstract must be written in English, presented in one paragraph, single-spaced, and italicized, with a maximum of 200 words. The beginning, clearly state the rationale behind conducting the study and show the novelty/gaps by addressing from general to specific problems to introduce new or original findings. The abstract is not an introduction or a conclusion, but should be limited to the following components: (1) The main research question and the background of the issue discussed; (2) The position of the study in relation to previous research; (3) A brief explanation of the method used to address the research question; and (4) The main findings or outcomes of the study. Other important aspects of the article that make a significant contribution to the research findings may also be included, provided the content fits within the abstract's word limit.

Introduction

Introduction consists of four or five paragraphs containing:

First, authors describe the issues that become the background of the study, and social facts related to the issues. Authors also present evidences in relation to the issues which are the focus of the study.

Second, authors show the novelty of the study by presenting the relevant previous studies. In this part, authors do not only mention the previous author's name, but also describe the study (and the findings) briefly. Then, authors show what has been studied and what has **yet** to be studied in the previous works.

Third, authors explain what is/are differences between the previous literature studies and the current one.

Fourth, authors describe the argumentation or hypotheses on the issue discussed in the current study.

Authors are obliged to **write in-note** to complete the statements written in the article. This is to validate what is presented and to show that those written statements are based on the actual facts and research results (**last name year**, page) (**Syarifah 2020**, 15).

Research Method



This section presents briefly about the analysis unit (research object) and the methodology implemented by the authors (Creswell 2014, 95). It also includes the research approach, the primary and secondary data sources. The sources might be from respondents, informants, texts or manuscripts. The authors also explain how the data are collected and analyzed.

Results and Discussion

Results: Generally, this part answers the research problems mentioned in Introduction by presenting the research data. The answers are validated by the research results. They are not only written, but also presented in the forms of tables, images, graphics, or interview results, so the research content is well-comprehended by the readers (Miski 2019, 122).

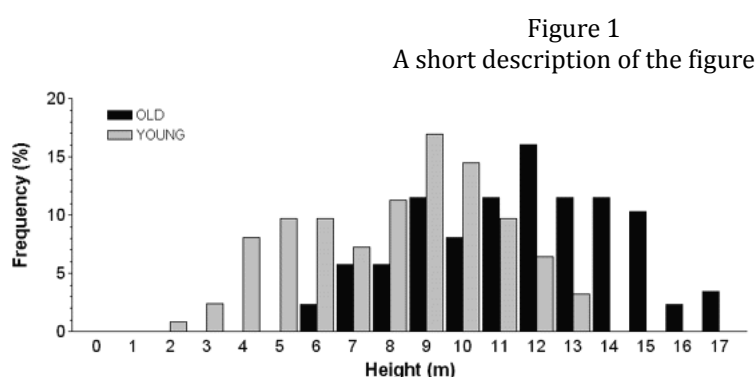
Discussion: All the research results should be referred to the implemented theory and approach (Afwadzi 2019, 37). This part should describe the significance of the research results. How relevant it is to answer the problems mentioned earlier in Introduction. If any, there should be comparison between this current research results with the previous research. Although it is not an obligatory, it is recommended to improve the article position. It will be better if the author provides if there is any relevance with other studies. Do not forget to provide in-note for every statement taken from different sources (Firdausy et al. 2019, 11).

All figures and tables should be cited in the text as Figure 1, Table 1, etc. They are made in gray. If it is in colors, it should be readable when printed in gray. Description must be in a single space. All symbols and abbreviated descriptions must be explained. Avoid using words that state the figure or table, such as “figure below” or “table as follows” because its position will be rearranged in the setting.

When presenting a picture as additional data for the research, please make sure that the picture is in HD quality.



If one or more verses of the Quran are quoted, do not write the Arabic version, instead, write the English translation in direct quoting (**make sure that the translation is from the trusted source, NOT the amateur one**), for example: *khamr* has been prohibited by Allah in Q.S. al-Maidah [5]: 90,

“O you who have believed, indeed, intoxicants, gambling, [sacrificing on] stone alters [to other than Allah], and divining arrows are but defilement from the work of Satan, so avoid it that you may be successful.”

For hadith, the in-note is (**al-Sijistânî n.d., vol. 4, no. 507, 76**). You need to write the hadith’s translation in English,

“Make sure the translation is from the trusted source, not the amateur one.”

This format is also applied when you directly quote the interview transcript, if authors used interview when collecting research data.

Conclusion

We encourage authors to write the essential findings of the research, as well as its scientific contribution to the field of science. Authors are expected to present their study limitation, so it can be the reference for the next research. Conclusion should be concise and clear that it does not lead to further questions. It covers the answers to problems presented in the beginning of the article, whether the issues are solved in this study or not. It has statements that strengthen the research findings.

References

References should be written according to the *American Psychological Association* (APA) Style of the 7th edition. The References contains only from the taken sources. **Make sure that all references mentioned in the in-note (from the article body) are listed in References.** They must be 15 references at least, in which 80% are from the scientific journal (Scopus-indexed ones are recommended) published in the last 5 years. We suggest authors to use reference managers such as Mendeley and Zotero to avoid typing mistakes and duplicated references.

General Guidelines

Articles should include research results, preliminary study results, or the author's original ideas, which have not been previously published. The number of words in the article is 6,000 to 8,000.

Page Setup

The article should be typed on A4 paper, with Right-Left margins: 3 cm, Top-Bottom: 4 cm, using Cambria 12pt font, and for Arabic script, Traditional Arabic 16pt font. The manuscript should not exceed 20 pages (initial page - References).

Subheadings

Each subheading (Introduction, Method, Research Results, Conclusion) should be typed in the order of A, B, C, D, written in bold, with Capital Each Word, Cambria 12pt.

Language

The article should be consistently typed in English. Similarly, the Abstract must be in English and Indonesian.

Plagiarism Check

Submitted articles will be checked for plagiarism (maximum 20%) using plagiarism software, and will then adjust to the OJS managerial mechanism.

Saving

The Microsoft Words file must be saved in RTF format.

- Click File > Save As or press F12.
