If we click the Backups menu item, you can see the daily backups here. You have hourly manual backups, and that's what we're going to do. We're going to create a manual backup. As you can see, I already created one, but we're going to make another one to show you how easy this process is.

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We're going to click Backup. Sorry for that. We give it a title, Page Builder Backup 2, and then we press Create Backup. Now, this is going to take a while, and I might need to cut this video unless it's going to be a little bit too long. But here we go. The backup has been created. If you want to put this backup in, let's say, your staging environment, you can easily use the restore to functionality and say, let's see if we can move this one to the premium dev environment. So we enter the text here. And then we say, let's check. We want a translation testing website from our live environment, the backup. We want to move it to the premium environment, the staging environment that we have. This will overwrite everything, and that's what we want because we want to have a live copy on the staging site. So we're going to press restore backup. And now Mike has started to move this backup to the staging environment. And after a few moments, it's done. And we have the website that is live on our live environment now copied to our staging environment. Next, let's talk about staging environments.

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This is an absolute game changer for anyone who regularly updates their websites or wants to experiment with new features or designs. How often have you hesitated before installing a new plugin, updating your theme or making significant CSS modifications because you were worried about breaking your live site and potentially impacting your visitors. Kinsta provides you with the ability to create one-click staging environments. These are essentially fully functional, isolated copies of your live website where you can freely test, experiment, and make changes without any risk whatsoever to your public-facing site. Imagine being able to thoroughly test a new plugin for compatibility issues, redesign your homepage, or implement significant code changes in a safe space. Let's take a quick visual tour of how straightforward it is to manage staging environment with mykinsta.

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So looking at the site information on mykinsta, we can see the following information here. There is this live environment which is selected now in the top bar, and you can see which environments are available. We can see the live environment and the premium environment, which stands for premium staging environment. And below that is a button which is called push environment. And that button, we are going to click it, and there is only one option there. We can push to the premium and staging environment. You can do a selection of what you want to push. So you might only want to push files if you want to change some files there. You might only want to push a database if you have a busy site and you want to test new database updates with your staging website. You can also run a search and replace so that all domain names that are registered in the database and/or files will be replaced. We're going to copy this text and we're going to push button to create the staging environment. And that's basically it. Kinsta does all the work for you, creates the new staging environment, and duplicates the website.

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As you can see, pushing to a staging environment is very easy. I can then make my changes here, verify everything looks and functions as expected, and then with another simple click, push those changes live to my actual website. It's incredibly efficient. Finally, within our peace of mind pillar, we have our exceptional support team. Inevitably, questions arise, or sometimes, despite our best effort, issues occur. When that happens, you need help. optimisation can be made. This empowers you to make informed decisions about your website's performance. Let me give you a short, in-depth look at the power of Kinsta APM. So looking at the site information screen in myKinsta again, we have the APM menu option right there in the menu.

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We click APM, and immediately you can see the clearness of this screen. It gives you an easy overview of what is happening with your site. Before I recorded this video, I recorded transactions with APM. You can set a certain time for it to record it. We have to look back in time for the last 12 2 hours and apply this time frame, and then you can see the transactions that have happened on this site during those 2 hours of monitoring. I have to say that this website is not very heavy, it's not very complex. It just has a few basic plugins installed. It has a default theme, it has some pages, and that's about it. But this should give you a little overview of what is happening on this site and how you can use Kinsta APM to find slow transactions. Overall, the transaction time consists of PHP and MySQL transaction times. And the slowest transactions, which is the most important thing to look at if you are looking for problems or how to solve these problems, you can see them over here, the slowest transactions. You can see WP Cron is taking up some time.

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Some stuff is happening there. We might investigate what that is, but at this point, we are not going to do that because we have other stuff to do. I have to tell you a little bit more about Kinsta APM. Let's scroll to the top and take a look at the WordPress section. In this WordPress section, you can see the slowest WordPress plugins, which doesn't mean they are slowest WordPress plugins ever. But in case of our transactions, the plugin that uses the most cycles, takes the most time is listed here on top. You can dive into further details, check your code, check if you have maybe performance updates of this plugin and check it out. The other thing to look at here is the slowest WordPress hooks. If you're not aware with hooks in WordPress, please use the search option on our website and check for hooks because we have a nice article explaining what these hooks are. If you know what hooks are, this can give you very much insight in what hooks trigger code that is slow. If we scroll back, we can

also take a look at database queries. We can actually see here which database queries take on the most time for every transaction that happens on our website.

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You can also take a look at external requests, but in this case, because I said, we use a simple theme, in this case, in a simple website, we don't have any external transactions. I hope this gives you a nice overview and a very small overview of Kinsta APM and how it can help you monitor the performance of your WordPress website.

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Next, let's discuss automation. Keeping your WordPress plugins and themes up to date is absolutely essential for both security and ensuring compatibility with the latest WordPress versions. However, the update process can sometimes be a source of anxiety. What if an update introduces a conflict or breaks a critical part of your website?
