What is your Mission Statement?

Northern Door Children's Center (NDCC) is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to providing quality primary care in a safe, secure environment that enhances personal growth and educational development for the young citizens of Northern Door County in partnership with the parents and the community.

Private tuition is our main source of funding providing approximately 60 % of our operating budget.

What is the geographic scope of your services throughout Door County?

We serve children and families from Forestville north to Washington Island with the majority of our clients living in northern Door, excluding Washington Island.

We provide early care and education for children ages 6 weeks through age eleven, including an infant/toddler looping program, 3K, collaborative publicly funded 4K, and a school age summer day camp.
