Tardy Policy:

- There will be a 1 minute warning bell before the Tardy Bell rings.
- Once the Bell rings if you are still in the Hallway, you will be marked Tardy.
- Consequences for the following number of Tardies:
 - 3 = Official Warning
 - 6 = Lunch Detention

*Tardies are cumulative and not by period.

ID Policy:

- All students must have on their school issued ID from the time they enter the building until the time they leave the building

Cell Phone Policy:

Homework:

Any work that you do not complete in class will then be considered Homework. There will be times when homework is assigned and it is expected to be shown at the beginning of the following class.

Make-up Work:

If a student is absent, this follows the make-up work policy:

- The student gets the number of days absent plus one day
- The make-up work policy takes place when a student is absent for any reason (ISS, OSS, etc...)
- The student must attend a remediation to make up tests/quizzes missed

Late Work Policy:

If the student does not turn the assignment in on time, Follow this Policy:

- Assignment needs to be submitted as soon as possible
- Any work from a previous quarter will NOT be accepted
