Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Santa's Delivery (159583)
- Card Stock (CS) –Cherry Cobbler (119685); Blushing Bride (131198); Shaded Spruce (146981); Basic White (159276); Basic White Thick (159229)
- Ink Pads Shaded Spruce (147088)
- Misc. Santa Express Designer Series Paper (DSP) (159582); Santa's Train Dies (159589); Foam Adhesive Sheets (152815); Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Bone Folder (102300); Paper Snips Scissors (103579); Paper Trimmer (152392); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)

Measurements:

- Cherry Cobbler CS: 8 1/2" x 7", scored in half at 3 1/2"
- Blushing Bride CS: 8 3/8" x 3 3/8"
- Shaded Spruce CS: 8 1/4" x 3 1/4"
- DSP layer: 8 1/8" x 3 1/8"; one engine and two cars cut with Santa's Train Dies
- Basic White CS: 8 1/4" x 3 1/4" for the inside; scrap for the sentiment
- Basic White Thick CS: 8 ½" x 3" to die cut one engine, two cars, and 3 puffs of steam

Instructions:

- 1. Burnish the fold in the card base with a Bone Folder.
- 2. Glue the Blushing Bride CS layer onto the front of the card base.
- 3. Glue the Shaded Spruce CS layer onto the Blushing Bride CS layer.
- 4. Glue the DSP layer onto the Shaded Spruce CS.
- 5. Glue the DSP engine and cars onto the Basic White Thick CS engine and cars.
- 6. Stamp the sentiment in Shaded Spruce ink onto the scrap of Basic White CS, then cut apart with Paper Snips.
- 7. Glue the two sentiment pieces onto the two cars.
- 8. Adhere the engine, two cars, and steam puffs onto the DSP layer using Foam Adhesive Sheets, filling in with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Stamp HoHoHo in Shaded Spruce ink onto the 8 1/4" x 3 1/4" Basic White CS for the inside, then glue to the inside of the base.
