



KEARNEY HIGH SCHOOL PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION:

Parking on Kearney High School property is a privilege. All parking lots are available for student parking except the faculty parking lot located on the northeast corner of the school campus and the parking stalls in the south lot designated for teachers/coaches. Students who purchase a permit are obligated to demonstrate **BEARCAT STYLE AND PRIDE** which includes being:

- **RESPECTFUL** - This includes not parking in stalls designated for visitors or those with disabilities. Additionally, being respectful includes not burning out, revving your engines, using foul language towards others, or speeding.
- **RESPONSIBLE** - This means that you, as a driver, understand that operating a motor vehicle requires great responsibility and that in order to have a safe and secure parking lot, it is your responsibility to follow all traffic laws and be safe.
- **SAFE** - This means that you will not demonstrate “road rage” and that you will be kind to others in our parking lot without using profanity. This includes not using your horn unless it is absolutely necessary to remain safe as well as observing right of ways and letting others in to traffic when there are traffic jams. This also means that you are cognizant of what is going on around you. This includes not texting while driving, and also obeying all traffic laws.

Purchasing a parking permit does not guarantee you a parking spot in the KHS parking lots, but rather, grants you access to park on the property. Once you enter the school parking lots, you are to park your vehicle with an authorized KHS Parking Permit. Parking permits can be purchased by the student driver in the Administrative Office for \$10.00 (check to KHS or exact cash).

Students who park illegally or who are not demonstrating **BEARCAT STYLE AND PRIDE** may have their vehicles ticketed, booted, or towed away. This may occur when you park in the faculty parking lot, park in a handicap area (indicated by blue paint), double park, park in fire lanes (indicated by red paint), on the grass, parking in any prohibited areas as designated by yellow hash lines, or have excessive unpaid tickets. If a ticket is issued for any reason, the fine is \$20 per ticket. If a fine total reaches \$100, the student’s vehicle may be booted. The boot will remain on the vehicle until the fine is paid or a payment plan is established through the Administrative Office.

Appealing a Ticket Students have 24 hours to appeal a ticket to the KHS Administrative Office unless they have received a ticket when the following day is not a scheduled day of school. Due to the fact that students may drive several vehicles to school, it is important that fines get paid immediately to avoid multiple tickets. Search of Motor Vehicles The privilege of bringing a vehicle onto school premises is hereby conditioned on written consent by the student driver, the owner of the vehicle, and the parent/guardian of the student to allow a search of that motor vehicle when there is reasonable suspicion for the search of that motor vehicle. Refusal by a student, parent/guardian, or the motor vehicle owner to provide or allow access to a motor vehicle on school premises at the time of a request to search the motor vehicle, shall be cause for termination, without further hearing, of the privilege of bringing a motor vehicle onto school premises. The principal, or a member of the administrative staff designated in writing by the principal, may request a law enforcement officer to search a motor vehicle on school premises.
