 - Must try: Vegan (Tofu) wok, Beetroot Hummus, Cocktails.

 - Notes: Near Old town, Outdoor seating, Great ambiance, open late.

 - Must try: Falafel Wraps
 - Price range: €5-10*

 - Must try: Samosa, Garlic Naan, Dal Makhani, Paneer Tikka.

 - Notes: ONLY ACCEPTS CASH, Near old town, good for take out, open late.
- 5. Fig - Hvar - Side Street of Downtown Hvar**
 - Must try: Veggie Burger, Veggies with Hummus, Loaded fries.
 - Price range: €15-25*
 - Hours: 9am-11pm**
 - Notes: Outdoor seating, Great Vibes, Good Cocktails
- 6. Pizzeria Fortuna - Promosten**
 - Must try: four cheese Gnocchi, Veggie Burger, and Bruschetta
 - Price range: €15-25*

- Hours: 7am-12am**
 - Notes: Primosten old town, Outdoor seating by the dock, Open late.
7. **Dubravka 1836 - Dubrovnik**
- Must try: Croissants, Coffee, Fresh Pizza, Burrata Pizza.
 - Price range: €5-10*
 - Hours: 8am-2am**
 - Notes: Great Breakfast/Brunch spot, Old town, Best views of the wall. Outdoor seating.
8. **Cafe Festival - Dubrovnik**
- Must try: Caprese Salad, Spinach Artichoke Dip, Multigrain Sandwich, Espresso Martini (Absolute favorite)
 - Price range: €5-10*
 - Hours: 8am-2am**
 - Notes: Old town, Live Music. Outdoor seating.
9. **Mezzanave - Dubrovnik**
- Must try: Vegetarian rolls, Wok with Vegetables, Nutella pizza
 - Price range: €10-15*
 - Hours: 8am-11pm**
 - Notes: Near Old town, Outdoor seating.
10. **La Bodega - Dubrovnik**
- Must try: Tofu Sushi, Spring rolls, Veggie Burger, Cocktails
 - Price range: €€*
 - Hours: 9am-2am**
 - Notes: Within Old town near the gate, Outdoor seating.
