HOMEBOUND STUDENTS

Students with extended or chronic illness or injury may qualify for homebound instruction. To be eligible, a physician must complete a Physician's Referral Form documenting that the student has one of the following:

- 1. An illness or injury that will require hospitalization or homebound care for a minimum of twenty (20) consecutive instructional days, or if the illness occurs less than twenty (20) days prior to the end of the school year and the student needs instruction to meet promotion or graduation requirements, that the student will require hospitalization or homebound care through the end of the current school year.
- 2. The student has a chronic illness or other medical condition that will require periodic hospitalization or homebound care for an aggregate of at least twenty (20) instructional days over the period of the school year.
