This note file is a MASSIVE (100K+ characters long) collection of my notes on crafting story writing prompts for Chat GPT. It also has a lot of raw outputs from Chat GPT that I used to help in rewriting these story writing prompts.

Basically, this is what I do when prompting for a story.

Originally, I started off with a blank slate and I needed instructions for HOW to write the story. I wanted heavy focus on dialog, inner dialog, sensations, etc. So I started out by just telling Chat GPT these things and having it help me write instructional creative prompts to guide the writing style to what I wanted. Then I expanded on these, had it shorten them, expanded on them some more, shortened it more, repeating the process until I had a text file full of instructional prompts of various lengths for various scenarios.

I would write a basic summary of the plot and opening scene to a story that I wanted it to write.

I would describe a character in specific detail like gender, physical description, background, etc and I would have Chat GPT expand upon it and write a longer description filled with details. Then I would have it change details of that character description and shorten it. Once I have a good character description created, I can reuse it for other stories.

Sometimes I would tell it to rewrite its story message to change details to how I wanted it. Then when continuing, I'd start with "Continue." and I'd describe the details of the next scene along with a recap of previous events and character descriptions of all characters. In the continues, I'd avoid using the writing style prompts due to context size (the AI's memory).

You can use Chat GPT to write the story recaps.

Without those recaps and character descriptions in every message, it starts hallucinating plot details and changing things that I didn't want it to change. I've become very experienced at getting Chat GPT to do what I want.

I started having a chat specifically for stories. I'd start with a building process where I ask for a basic story and inject a huge amount of writing style prompts. I'd do continues and include the extremely long writing style prompts. By the end of the process of building the chat, the writing style would be influenced to become my desired style of story, no longer requiring much of writing style prompts.

Then I'd do all my stories inside that chat until it got so long that it becomes laggy to use (Galaxy Fold 3 at the time) and eventually Chat GPT refused to allow any more messages in the chat
