("we," "us,"

or "our") and the educational institutions

("School,"

"District," or "Customer") using our services.

I. Terms of Service

Effective Date: March 3, 2026

1. Acceptance of Terms

By creating an account, installing our software,
or using

the AntBlocked service, you agree to be bound
by

these Terms of Service. If you are entering into
this

agreement on behalf of a school or district, you represent that you have the authority to bind that entity.

2. Description of Service

AntBlocked provides a suite of school-focused tools,
including:

- Content Filtering: Real-time blocking of inappropriate web content.
- Classroom Management: Tools for teachers to monitor and manage student digital activity.
- Student Safety (Beacon): AI-driven detection of content related to self-harm, violence, or bullying.

3. School Personnel & Student Data

- School Official Status: For the purposes of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), AntBlocked acts as a "School Official" with a legitimate educational interest. We remain under the direct control of the School regarding the use and maintenance of education records.
- Consent: The School is responsible for obtaining any necessary parental consent under the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) before allowing students under 13 to use the Service.

4. Data Ownership and Use

- Ownership: The School retains all ownership rights to any Student Data provided to or collected by AntBlocked.
- Limited License: The School grants AntBlocked a non-exclusive, limited license to use Student Data solely to provide and improve the Service.
- No Sale of Data: AntBlocked will never sell Student Data to third parties or use it for targeted advertising.

5. Account Security

The School is responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of administrative and teacher

account
credentials. Any unauthorized access must be
reported
to AntBlocked immediately at
security@antblocked.com.

6. Termination

- By School: You may terminate your subscription at any time.
- By AntBlocked: We reserve the right to suspend or terminate access if these Terms are violated.
- Data Deletion: Upon termination, we will delete or de-identify Student Data in our possession within thirty (30) days, unless a shorter period

is required
by local law.

II. Privacy Policy

1. Information We Collect

We collect information only to the extent
necessary to
provide the services requested by the School:

- Directly Provided: Administrator/Teacher
names,
school email addresses, and school
contact
information.
- Student Information: Student names and
school-
issued IDs/emails as provided by the
School's
directory integration (e.g., Google

Workspace or
Microsoft 365).

- Usage Data: Browsing history, search queries, and timestamps from school-managed devices.
- Safety Data: Content flagged by our AI for review by school safety teams.

2. How We Use Information

We use the information to:

- Filter web content according to School-defined policies.
- Provide teachers with visibility into active classroom sessions.

- Notify designated school staff of potential safety concerns.
- Analyze and improve the accuracy of our filtering algorithms (using de-identified data).

3. Data Sharing & Third Parties

We do not share personal information with third parties except:

- With the School: Information is shared back with authorized school personnel.
- Sub-processors: We use trusted infrastructure providers (e.g., cloud hosting) that meet our strict security standards.

- Legal Requirements: If required by a valid legal order (e.g., a subpoena), we will notify the School unless prohibited by law.

4. Security Measures

We maintain a robust security program including:

- Encryption: Data is encrypted at rest and in transit using industry-standard protocols.
- Access Controls: Access to student data is restricted to authorized employees with a specific "need-to-know" for technical support.
- Audits: We perform regular security vulnerability assessments and internal audits.

5. Individual Rights

Parents and students who wish to review, correct, or delete personal information must contact their School or District. As a service provider, AntBlocked will assist the School in fulfilling these requests.

6. Updates to this Policy

We may update this policy to reflect changes in law or our Service. We will notify Schools of any material changes via email or an in-app notification.

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
