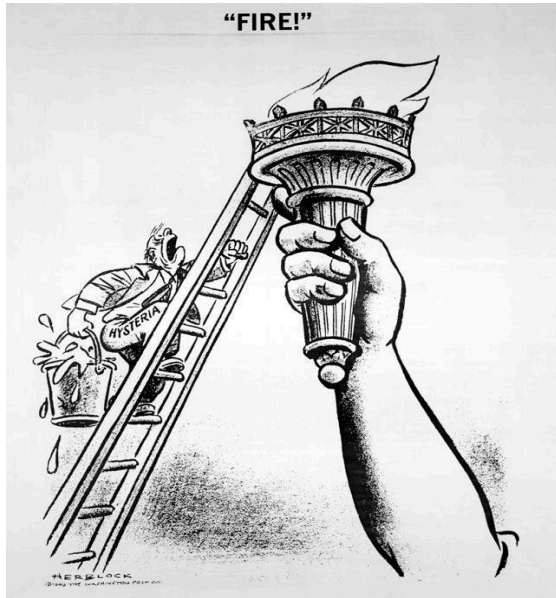


III. Cold War Comes Home

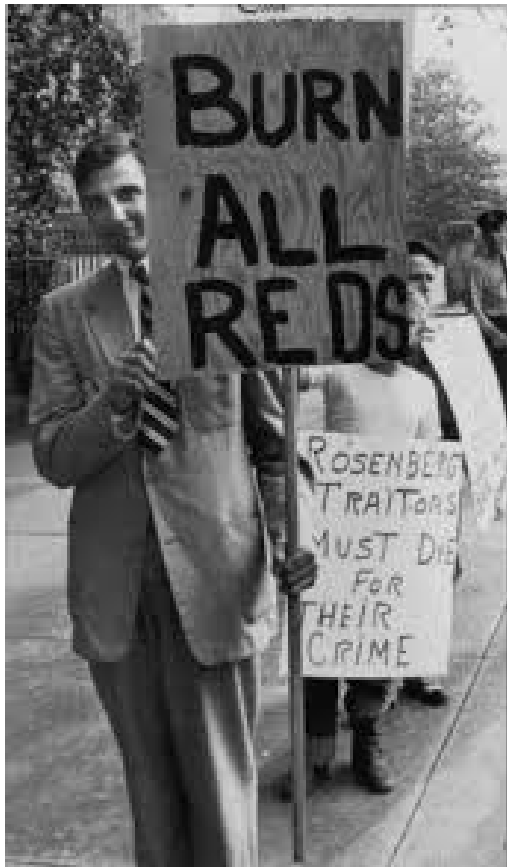
