Background:

- Born a miqu'te of the Mi tribe, a recent offshoot of the M tribe based in Gyr Abania, daughter of Mi'lion Nunh
- The tribe was kind of struggling for a lot of reasons for most of her life, being unable to find a good place to settle and falling victim to illnesses and food shortages often, and she saw a lot of Nunhs come and go over time (her father was killed in a battle for the title when she was 7). There were always two Nunhs at a time when she was a kid but during her teens the number fell to just one as tribe numbers dwindled
- This was just going on in the background for Mi'dnight. She was a fighter girl and a lesbian from birth, and spent her teen and young adult years getting into fights and kissing girls. She was very good at both of these things
- The Nunh who took over when she was 20, one Mi'stoh Nunh, was pretty pissed off by this because he basically thought she was taking all the young women in the tribe from him which was unacceptable in the kind of situation their tribe was in, he needed to have as many kids as possible, obviously :/
- Incel Nunh mad that chad lesbian gets all the ladies
- Anyway Mi'stoh was always on her case and threatening to exile her from the tribe and such (but didn't, because they needed anyone they could get), and eventually she was like you know what, if it bothers you so much, I'll challenge you to become the Nunh. Mi'stoh was like what no you can't be the Nunh that's ridiculous. She was like okay, defeat me then
- Spoiler, he did not defeat her. Guess she's the Nunh now!
- All the men in the tribe were like what the fuck you can't be Nunh, our tribe will die out, and she was like whatever man! If you have a problem all you have to do is defeat me! So they all came at her and she was being challenged all the time, but none of them could defeat her so no way could they dethrone her as the Nunh, it's just the rules!

- Some of the women did have reservations about Mi'dnight as Nunh, but tbh she was already really popular and Mi'stoh Nunh was Not so loads of them were like Hell Yes and very much embraced the concept
- A lot of people left the tribe when it became apparent that Mi'dnight Nunh was here to stay. Many of the men left the tribe altogether, and the men who didn't formally leave went off to train in the hopes of becoming strong enough to defeat Mi'dnight. The only men who stayed with the group were this one gay couple who were like I mean, sure, doesn't matter to us bro!
- The women who weren't into the idea of a female Nunh at all also left, but it was a surprisingly small number. Rates of bisexuality are incredibly high in miqu'tes my uncle works at Squeenix and told me
- So the tribe turned into Mi'dnight and her 15 girlfriends (plus those two guys) (and also her sister who just stayed bc they're buds), basically
- Needless to say everyone in the tribe was having a whale of a time
- The question of what they would do about ensuring the tribe survived another generation Did come up but nobody was super fussed about it bc everyone was having a great time. Some of the women had children with previous Nunhs who the tribe continued to raise together
- Around a year after Mi'dnight had become the Nunh, the tribe met with a young girl named Ka'celhe. She was an orphaned Ala Mhigan refugee now living at Rhalgr's Reach, and she pretty much had nothing. She bonded a lot with Mi'dnight's close friend Mi'yau, and Mi'yau decided to adopt her formally and raise her as a child of the Mi tribe
- This kind of opened a bit of a door. On their travels the Mi tribe met many children who had lost everything one way or another, and members of the tribe would adopt these children, whether miqu'tes or not
- Word spread somewhat about the Mi tribe, a place where lesbians and other wlw could live a freer life, but also where people of all walks of life were welcome - other adults ended up approaching the tribe with intent to join, not all of them miqu'tes
- Mi'dnight ended up being really proud of what had become of the tribe after she became Nunh, she'd initially pretty much become Nunh just to shut Mi'stoh up but now she was really passionate about it
- But she knew that maintaining what she had built was contingent on her remaining the Nunh, if she were defeated by a male challenger all would be lost - and a number of men of the Mi tribe were still out there somewhere, training to be able to fight her
- In the end she made the tough choice to leave the tribe in Mi'yau's care while she went on a journey, without stepping down as Nunh, with the idea that she couldn't be challenged and dethroned if her would-be challengers couldn't find her
- She went as far as Limsa and joined the marauder's guild so she could train further and become stronger, so that in the case that any challengers did come after her, she would be all the more equipped to defeat them and continue to protect what she had created

Character:

- Assigned chad at birth

- She radiates a kind of gently cocky confidence which the men in her tribe hated but it works for her usually
- Always dtf (is that down to fuck or down to fight? Why Not Both)
- She gets into fights easily bc she enjoys winding people up and fears nothing. And also likes fighting. She is Powerful and knows it
- She is a terrible flirt tho whenever she sees a lady she is just ;333
- Being like that got her like 20 girlfriends tho so. She's good at what she does
- She's like not particularly smart but she's straightforward and her rascal charms get her by usually
- She automatically becomes a fun aunt/big sister to anyone noticeably younger than her. Including her actual kids she is more of a fun aunt to them than a parental figure but she does her best
- She's a compassionate and justice driven person generally. She wants people to be happy and free to do what they want and mostly gets mad at people who stop others from doing that
