and

An Inventory of the Goods, Plate &c. of the late Lady Brownlowe at Belton taken April 2nd 1754

Notes: The above two inventories follow the same numbering system and have been combined below, VT – Viscount Tyrconnel, LB – Lady Brownlow. It is believed that the items listed as belonging to 'the late Lady Brownlowe' were the inheritance of Lady Anne Cust and were therefore not part of the freehold estate of Viscount Tyrconnel, so listed separately.

No rooms were named on the VT inventory, with the exception of Bellmount. Six rooms were named on the LB inventory.

The rooms mostly follow a logical sequence on the ground so where there is a fair degree of certainty they have been assigned the names used on the 1737 inventory (BNLW/2/2/7/6) preceded by /, and the current room names have been added in square brackets, with an acknowledgment of the work of Rosalind Westwood (1980s) and Ian Ross, Belton Research Group.
