### League Requirements

1. Dues paid in full ~ 30 teams still yet to pay (as of Sunday)
2. Safe Sport – 1 TSA Rep and one Coach minimum
  - a. You will find the Safe sport link on the league website ([also see Tracey's email](#)). If you are a USA swimming official or have taken SS this calendar year, please send a screen shot of your Certificate of completion to Tracey Mizell
  - a. Minimum required, but as many as you would like can take the free Course
0. Coach's Code of Conduct
  - a. All coaches must sign the Code of Conduct by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - a. Code of Conduct is found on the league website, under 2024 Rule Book. It is the last page.
0. Stroke and Turn Officials – training provided
  - a. Free clinics
  - a. Online training – paid by club or volunteer
  - a. Email credentials of a USA Swimming official prior to June 11<sup>th</sup>
0. SwimTopia Team and Meet Management
  - a. Registration of all TSA swimmers via individual club SwimTopia websites
  - a. Use Meet Maestro as Meet Management

- . Swimmers will sign up for meets through SwimTopia club websites
- . Coaches will seed all dual meets in Meet Maestro
- . Scoring of dual meets will be entered into Meet Maestro using times recorded for all main events 1-6<sup>th</sup> place
- . Use of Traditional Scoring pages is optional. You can find the pages on the League website under Printable Forms
- . Collecting times other than first place is optional
- . Any timing system is welcome, but is at the discretion of the home team
- . TSA will not print out scoring pages, pinks/blues or rule book. All forms can be found on league website and printed by club if desired
- i. DQ slips will be printed and handed out at the Mega Clinics

### Clinics Committee

1. John Martin to present schedule. Will be posted to the league website as soon and as possible
2. Meet attendance will be counted by clubs who send someone to attend this training.
3. Alternatively, if you are familiar with Meet Maestro, your attendance will be counted by picking up DQ slips at the Mega Clinics. Your coach can do this.

Guidance or etiquette on how we approach a meet and treat each other

- Home team TSA Rep will email the visiting team’s Rep Thursday before the scheduled Tuesday night meet.
- Content of the email should include
  - Directions to club, and where visiting team sets up on home deck
  - Parking instructions
  - Concessions offered or not
  - Any additional relays offered, i.e. Coach’s relay
  - Any other items that may be useful to a guest
- Home and Visiting teams will enter meet line up into Meet Maestro by midnight Sunday evening prior to the scheduled meet
- Home team locks and merges entries by 10:00 am Monday so both teams can print necessary paperwork (or approximately 32 hours prior to meet start)
  - **?? Discuss option of Home team printing all materials for both teams??**

- Home team will leave meet open for additional times to be entered up to Thursday night (or approx. 48 hours after the conclusion of the meet)
- Any other ideas to help streamline process?

#### **League Wide Team Management Requirements:**

League-wide adoption to SwimTopia was approved by BOD vote in October 2021. League fees will cover the cost of this system for all teams. Annual TSA fees are increasing slightly for 2024.

- All clubs had access to full SwimTopia accounts as of the 2022 season. If you have not yet logged on and set up your team's page, please contact SwimTopia for assistance.
- Please make sure all teams have detailed info about your club on your Swimtopia team page (e.g. pool location, light status, number of lanes, concessions, timing system, etc.)

- All teams must use SwimTopia for registration for all swimmers. This is how we will assess TSA dues this summer and in all future seasons.
- Tutorials and demos are available on the league website for topics such as: setting up your team site, registration pages, volunteer registration (template possible this summer just need some great examples), and how to set up meet entries, etc.
