If you're scaling (150–200+ students): Evaluate native mobile engagement, automated pro-rata/makeups at cohort level, outcomes/goal tracking, and multi-site controls. Tools built for larger academies (e.g., Outcoach) may suit better.

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What is MyMusicStaff (MMS)?

[MyMusicStaff](#) (MMS) is a Canadian class management platform built specifically for private music teachers and small studios. It has become popular in the music industry because it focuses on features that solo instructors and small schools need most. Having started in the last 7-10

years, MMS brings expertise to the music teaching landscape with features and designs that exclusively centre on music. Right from repertoire practices to scheduling and teacher management, it's a great starter-kit for music teachers and studios alike. It's even been reviewed as "[Perfect for solo studio owners](#)" or "[Great for starting a studio!](#)"

One of its strengths is that this platform is offered in [multiple languages](#) such as English, French, Japanese, Spanish, Dutch, and German which is beneficial to studios teaching internationally and/or online, allowing them to expand their reach by accommodating different languages without extra effort, making it a very convenient option to take into consideration. With a modern and simple design, MyMusicStaff is a well-rounded music platform for teachers. If you stumbled across this while looking for their [login, you can do that here](#).

What Works Well - An in-depth MyMusicStaff Review:

These features focus on the day-to-day admin that most teachers have to do, helping bring together many workflows in the one screen. While MyMusicStaff is well-suited to independent teachers, the question is whether it can meet the needs of growing music academies with multiple studios, large teaching teams and complex administrative demands? Pros and Cons - Is MyMusicStaff worth it in 2025?

For solo teachers and small studios, MyMusicStaff can be a great solution. At less than \$30/month, it provides scheduling, invoicing, and student tracking tools that cover **almost everything a small business needs**. The website builder can save hundreds of dollars compared to hiring a designer or paying for separate hosting.

The platform is intuitive, even for those who might not particularly like technology or computers. As a former teacher myself, playing around with the music teacher platform was fairly straightforward, particularly the ‘drag and drop’ music lesson scheduling features.

The third party integration options were particularly useful as your teaching schedule syncs to [your Google or Outlook Calendar](#) - a great feature for music teachers ‘on the go’ or juggling multiple other commitments like your kid’s tennis lessons or meetings from your other job. Teachers were able to generally find their way around the platform and the web portal was working as intended on the laptop for parents. MMS also offer free phone and email support for any customer by matching the studio with a customer representative agent which is a nice touch from the team.

Finally, MMS have recently published a [new feature announcement](#) with the arrival of students being able to book into a recurring lesson with a fixed end date. There also seems to be no hidden fees or ‘add-ons’ which allows for hassle-free lesson scheduling and music school invoicing.

This all sounds great, but is there anything I’m missing out on? Well, that really depends on your requirements as a music teacher! After having spoken to over 60 Australian music school teachers, MMS is generally well-regarded, but might *not* be *the most* effective tool for music school class management in Australia particularly. Here’s our insights:

What Might Not Work For You - An In-Depth MyMusicStaff Review:

Based on our learnings from how 60+ Australian music schools operate, using MMS ourselves and [Capterra reviews](#), the potential limitations are the following:

1. **No Mobile App or Parent Engagement:** We often hear how busy parents are with their full-time jobs, fulfilling uber duties for their kid's sports, cooking/cleaning/laundry, you name it. In the modern era, the mobile tends to be everything. There's [causal evidence](#) from K-12 that mobile/text parent communication improves attendance and outcomes; in higher-ed cohorts, mobile apps have been associated with [higher engagement and retention](#). While music academies differ, the actual mechanism (being timely nudges + clear progress) is the same. With automated reminders and an easy view over their child's homework/learning, it helps keep music education top of mind with any information being found right from their pocket. After all, [this happens in schools, so why shouldn't it happen here?](#)
2. **No Xero Integration & Invoicing Options:** It's no secret that payments are the lifeblood of any business. If you have over 150+ students, automated bulk invoicing across multiple types of classes per student is a huge time-saver. It's great that MyMusicStaff do offer calendar-based billing, but in Australia, a large number of music schools often use Xero or Myob for their accounting and bookkeeping. [Without a clear integration or sync](#), reconciling these invoices at scale can quickly become a nightmare. Moreover, mid-term enrolments, makeup classes and dropouts can cause invoicing complications quickly at scale.
3. **Student Progress Isn't Tied to Anything:** While MMS do offer repertoire tracking and practice logs, we found that it's not often the headline item due to its simplicity. In music particularly, parents *want* to see their child learn and improve (especially with all the [research tying music education to cognitive development](#)). With only repertoire tracking and practice logs, the entire learning journey often can't be tracked from start to finish. The first step often are clear goals outlining what the child will be working towards, homework tying their classes to the goals, videos to update progress, and finally exam results along with teacher feedback. Without a mobile app, we've seen that adoption of these features tends to be a bit harder as parents simply don't have the time to login on

the laptop to view the documents. This of course, ties back to parent engagement and student retention which is a core value point for music schools.

4. **Phone Support is Hard Because of Australian Timezones:** When it's our working time, it's 11pm in Canada or 3am in the UK. Admin is boring and when you're in the zone, you want answers, *fast*. It makes it hard having to contact the other side of the world (literally). It's not just timezones either, but also school term dates, holidays and more which can obviously be a hurdle for Australian music schools seeking lesson-specific help/advice.

Other mentions:

- **Running multiple locations** means you'll be juggling separate accounts and duplicate admins work. No easy way to manage each location independently.
- Reliance on **email for communication** can be less effective for today's busy parents, who are already drowned in emails and typically used to mobile-first access.

MyMusicStaff Pricing and Cost in 2025

MyMusicStaff uses a [per-teacher pricing model](#) where you pay US \$14.95 per month and an additional \$4.95 for each additional teacher or staff member. This pricing is quite reasonable and makes budgeting predictable for music studios. For a music studio with 5 teachers, MMS ends up costing around \$40 USD per month being a very reasonable rate. This makes MyMusicStaff one of the most affordable options for private teachers and music studios. However, for academies and music schools with more than 200 students, the lack of customisability may limit some of its overall value as there typically needs to be a greater level of automation and integration. Generally speaking though, the reception has been very positive. Of course, there can never be a 'one shoe fits all' model, but MMS does a great job of bringing together core admin (scheduling, invoicing, payroll) for efficient record-keeping and music school class management.

Another perspective is to also consider the opportunity costs which are often the unseen costs to your business by not considering the alternatives. By only focusing on admin, we still ignore one of the industry's biggest problems: student retention and engagement. We even wrote an article on this with the [Victorian Music Teaching Association](#). Did you know that saving just 3 students a year could keep up to \$5000+ back in your business if each student pays ~\$1700 a year?

Why Does Music Education Matter?

As music teachers, we especially know [Research](#) shows that music student performance:

- **Sharper thinking → Boosts memory, focus, and executive skills**
- **Confidence & connection → Builds resilience and self-expression**
- **Better performance → Math and Word reading; improves patterns recognition and problem-solving**

For academies, this would imply that tracking progress and showing parents visible results isn't just about features, it's the retention strategy that reinforces the educational value of class.

MyMusicStaff Alternatives

[Outcoach](#) is an Australian [music teacher platform](#) built for growing music schools. While providing very similar admin features as MyMusicStaff (detailed feature analysis below), Outcoach aims to encapsulate the full learning journey and increase parent engagement:

In the coming months, this AI assistant will even be able to perform key workflows like booking makeup classes, sending messages and handle scheduling conflicts. 'Voice-to-Text' has also been introduced to simply speak into goals or homework to create them. It uses AI to pick up on music-specific terminology and cut out irrelevant information.

- **[OTunes](#) → AI based AMEB Aural Training**

Outcoach has also introduced a new platform to help music schools and studios learn the AMEB curriculum via aural training. These multiple choice question and answers are generated using AI (so there's no limited question bank) with bars and audio files easily visible. With the introduction of Otunes, music teaching in Australia is revolutionised completely

- **Goal Breakdown and Visual Progress Tracker → Clear tasks, more efficient practice**

Students are given more focused tasks rather than vague "practice more" reminders. This promotes more efficient practice and encourages students. Parents know exactly what their child is working on, track milestones, and feel confident that their investment is paying off.

- **In-app messaging → Faster parent communication**

Instead of relying on email (which parents often miss or ignore), messages and notifications arrive directly in the app. Parents are far more likely to read and respond quickly.

- **Multi-studio management → Simple operations, less confusion**

For larger academies, the ability to organise and control multiple studios under one account reduces confusion and keeps operation intact. It ties back to all the reports having correct information per centre, giving you actionable insights.

Outcoach Pricing in 2025

Outcoach is priced at roughly \$1.00-\$1.50 per student per month depending on if you pay annually or monthly. Over time, a school with 200 students retaining a conservative 20% over 3 years, can result in \$80 000 (assuming each student pays \$2000 a year for music lessons) kept back in the business due to the student retention benefits. This value means that Outcoach has paid for itself 10-20x over by focusing on parent engagement.
