








# MCT Volunteer Jobs

Every meet runs on volunteers — and the good news is, most jobs still let you cheer for your swimmer! Sign up for a role below and help make the magic happen.

Job Title	What You'll Do	Time Commitment	Can You Watch Your Swimmer?
<b>Head Timer / Assistant Head Timer</b>	Start two stopwatches at the gun for every race and back up timers if their watches malfunction. Timing experience is a plus!	Arrive ~30 minutes early for the timers' meeting, then stay through the final race.	 Yes! You're right on the pool deck with a front-row view of all the action.
<b>Clerk of Course</b>	Check in swimmers, tell them their lanes, and guide them to the staging area before their race. A fantastic way to learn every kid on the team!	Present for the entire meet.	 Yes! You're near the pool and can easily step away to cheer on your swimmer.
<b>Ribbons</b>	Apply printed name-and-place labels to the correct ribbons. These are the treasures kids race home to show their families — don't underestimate this job!	Starts around the backstroke events (~¼ into the meet) and wraps up about 30 minutes after the final race.	 Yes! Pause the ribbon prep anytime to cheer for your swimmer, then jump back in.
<b>Verifier</b>	Sit at the automation table and confirm that race data is entered correctly. Accuracy matters — you're the last line of defense!	Present for the entire meet.	 Yes! Pause anytime to watch your swimmer's race.
<b>Timer</b>	Use a stopwatch to time each race and record the results. Meets literally cannot happen without timers — this is one of our most essential roles!	Arrive ~30 minutes early for the timers' meeting, then stay through the final race.	 Yes! You're on the pool deck with a great view of every heat.
<b>Transport MCT Tent (Away Meets)</b>	Pick up, transport, set up, then break down and return the team tent. Requires a truck, minivan, or other large vehicle.	Pick up Friday evening at the pep rally. Set up before the meet, tear down after.	 Absolutely! Once the tent is up, you're free until it's time to pack it away.
<b>50/50 Raffle Ticket Sales</b>	Roam the meet selling raffle tickets for our 50/50 drawing. The more you sell, the bigger the pot — get your sales pitch ready!	Arrive 30 minutes before the meet and sell through at least the breaststroke events.	 Yes! You're already wandering the meet — just stop and cheer whenever your swimmer races.
<b>Hospitality</b>	Help prepare and serve refreshments to our hardworking volunteers. A little food and appreciation go a long way on a long meet day!	Check in with the Hospitality coordinator before the meet, help serve during	 Yes! Step away anytime to watch your swimmer, then

<b>Parking Attendant</b>	Direct incoming cars so we can fit as many families as possible into the lot. Early birds get this done before the chaos starts!	Arrive early to set up. Once the meet begins, you're done!	🏊 Yes! You're finished before the first race — enjoy the whole meet.
<b>Runner</b>	Collect completed time sheets from timers and deliver them to the automation table. Fast feet, important job! Open to high-school-aged family members (14+) who aren't competing.	Active throughout the meet whenever time sheets need to be collected.	🏊 Yes! Take a break anytime to cheer for your swimmer.
<b>Snack Bar Worker</b>	Help run our home-meet concession stand — serve, grill, and keep the fans fueled. Multiple shifts available so you can pick what works for you.	Varies by shift — check the signup for specific times.	🏊 Yes! Step out anytime to catch your swimmer's race and then head back.
