SELF MEDICATION ON FIELD TRIPS

Students who have permission to self-medicate in school may also self-medicate on a field trip. We encourage parents of students who suffer from asthma or other potentially life threatening illnesses to accompany their child on field trips. When this is not possible, a student may self-medicate under the following conditions:

1. All medication to be self-administered by a student must be kept in the student's possession.
2. Students must secure their medication in such a manner that the medication will not be available to other students.
3. Students are to self-medicate under the supervision of a teacher who: has been trained by the school nurse in the proper administration of medication; and has charge of the student while on the field trip.
4. Students who self-medicate are to report each administration of medication and any side effects to a teacher, coach, or the individual in charge of the student during school administration.
