Welcome/Orientation 7:00-7:10 (10 min)

- All board members approve.

General Manager Update 7:15-7:25 (10 min)

- Sales are up (\$78K so far this month)
 - o Bananas, avocados, yellow onions, garlic, rice moving fast

- Store has been more consistently stocked, credit to merch
- Big shopping weekends leaving us bare, could increase our backstock
- Patrick: is open shopping adding a lift?
 - Theres: we have added an early week produce delivery
 - Amanda: UNFI is our main vendor for this, they have a limit of 100 cases. We have been trying to avoid backstock previously, but can adjust for quick moving items.
- Kombucha is fixed, have a good vendor in place
- New fridge is up and running: still have to put in shelving/tags/stock
- Turnstile is in, but needs to be flipped
- Card readers/iPad
 - Replaced iPad at second station this weekend, but card reader still not working
 - Replacing one item means replacing other items/processors
 - o Finance has approved buying new iPads Joel can go ahead and buy
 - o Travis, IT have doc with different plans/scenarios for full POS overhaul
- Proposal to present smaller design/build tasks to the general membership rather than just design/build listserv
 - o Hannah: question for membership on how to balance with staffing needs?

Committee Asks and Gives 7:25-7:30 (5 min) (Committee Chairs and Liaisons)

Committees ask for help or support / others give below:

- Natalie: Need support for flyering on weekends; outreach packets available in store as well
- Amanda: Work with marketing/ops to have someone take photos of produce on Friday both for social media and for Ops reference/guide material

Agenda 7:30-8:50 (80 min)

- I. Fridge update 7:50-8:00 (10 min)
 - A. Draft update/thank you note to GoFundMe donors, social media
 - 1. Joel, Ray to take lead
- II. Ways to improve the shopping experience 8:00-8:20 (20 min)
 - A. General cosmetic improvements: floor, shelves, paint, etc.
 - 1. Hannah: would it be possible to either shift this to floor attendants, or to schedule a morning/half-day "glow-up"?
 - 2. Joel: Yes, will make a list of smaller tasks that can be done and a date in February. Will push to Slack for sign-ups.
 - B. Card readers, contactless payment, showing a running total to shoppers as they are checking out. New/fixed produce or bulk scale
 - C. Credit cards?
 - 1. Amanda: could depend on the POS system, currently we pay a flat charge with Mercury, if we moved to Revel entirely then it would be a percentage. Can give more info in a month.
 - 2. Patrick: if we stay with Mercury could we do a credit card surcharge?
 - 3. Amanda: in NYC can't do a surcharge, has to be implemented as a discount for non-credit card payments
- III. Inviting CBFC members to shop 8:20-8:35 (15 min)
 - A. Isaac: Raina from CBFC presented proposal for cross-shopping to CBFC board. Had previously thought there may have been requirement for CBFC members to also work at

- GHFC. Clarified that was not the case, CBFC is interested and wants to hear fleshed out proposal.
- B. Isaac: noted concern that cross-shopping could cannibalize CBFC sales once they open, but can plan with this in mind.
- C. Hannahh: support this proposal, can revisit once CBFC opens a location
- D. Stefanie: maybe we can share best practices/lessons learned with CBFC as well
- E. Isaac: Agreed, would be in spirit of solidarity first mentioned in December
- F. Patrick: Support this idea, best practices document could also be helpful exercise for us as well.
- G. Brit: what exactly does CBFC want to see from us?
 - 1. Isaac: a stable offer with basic terms down in writing
- H. Hannah: could we also have an open offer for CBFC members to work a shift?
- I. Patrick: how would that land with CBFC?
 - 1. Isaac, would probably land well. May offer their members a chance to see how running a location looks
- J. Joel: many PSFC members approach asking if they can work, many people seem to appreciate having a place to contribute/show up to work
- K. Liz: second these sentiments, can phrase it as an invitation
- L. Stefanie: could be an opportunity for CBFC members to learn different roles
- M. Vote: Passes with unanimous support.
- N. Hannah and Isaac to work on drafting a proposal.
- IV. Possibility of hiring an assistant manager 8:35-8:50.(15 min)
 - A. Ray: it needs to happen, don't think the store can maintain momentum without adding staff. We need to offer our top candidates we've interviewed the job, with the understanding that we are in an improved financial position but not totally clear.
 - B. Luis: we can make projections, what timelines/scenarios should we look at?
 - 1. Ray: should model around hiring someone for at least a year
 - C. Zoe: the number of hours we offer is also key. The candidates we interviewed were looking for this to be their one job.
 - D. Patrick: in support broadly. Three good weeks of sales, January is generally a solid month, so don't want to make decision based on our recent financials alone.
 - E. Joel: agree with Patrick that we don't have enough info for us to be sure we are in a better position. Trying to emphasize making existing work more efficient/easier to train. Not ready yet to hire.
 - F. Renee: if we hire, should only be part time. Would like to see an increase in membership numbers before moving forward. Possible to hire on weekends at first, maybe?
 - G. Hannah: our job description/ad last fall probably attracted people looking more for full time. Could potentially do a search for more temporary assistants like we did at beginning of COVID.
 - H. Brit: what were the hours advertised in the fall?
 - 1. Hannah: 25, which is a sort of awkward in between part time and full time.
 - 2. Brit: so if we resumed hiring process with 15-20 hours listed we could get more applicants interested in part time?
 - 3. Hannah: yes, possibly. And the labor market has shifted in that time already. Sensing a shared caution, would like to hear more from Joel on viability of continuing with one staff.
 - I. Joel: small improvements like Ops Hub, IT changes being made by Emily, Travis are doing are key to making having one staff member more viable. With these changes there is a future where it is not super urgent to hire a second staff member.

- J. Hannah: perhaps we can restart convos hiring a staff member for outreach.
- K. Brit: have we been able to reduce our outstanding invoices in this last month?
 - 1. Ray: broadly, yes
 - 2. Brit: maybe we can use cost avoidance from hiring to pay off debts, but not rely on it in our general operating budget
- L. Patrick: revisit in one month when we have more info on increased sales
- M. Hannah + Zoe: touch base with applicants to let them know we haven't forgotten
- N. Luis: can do further financial projections to have ready for next month's meeting
- O. Amanda in chat: how viable is it to find someone with both grocery and outreach experience?
 - 1. Hannah: Not impossible, but not easy.

Patrick takes over as facilitator

- V. Membership drive 8:15-8:45 (20 min)
 - A. August:
 - 1. Successful weekend of flyering + outreach. Many positive convos on the sidewalk
 - 2. "Carrot" sign is up, looking to add more signage in store with messaging about campaign
 - 3. Outreach packages are in store, have weekly flyering on Saturday mornings.
 - 4. To-do: set up buddy system.
 - B. Natalie: don't have full numbers yet, so largely anecdotal but very positive so far
 - 1. Noticeably positive response to open shopping, effective way to invite people into the store.
 - 2. Collecting feedback that will be useful to inform further strategy/decision
 - 3. One quirk: several people said they tried to join but our website says we're not accepting members, but cannot find what they're talking about. Following up/investigating.
 - C. Patrick: plan to draft an email to general leave/recently deactivated list pitching them on returning to check out the store.
 - D. Patrick: proposal to make February an open shopping month for these groups.
 - E. Ian: tech questions depend on motive: do we want to collect info, or just serve as a check-in? Can devote attention to it either way.
 - F. Hannah: can we include question to this group about what made them leave, or offer a buddy?
 - G. Hannah: continue circulating our Linewaiters Gazette piece
 - H. Renee: working on survey w/r/t model change, so weary of doing too many surveys
 - I. August: advocate giving the membership drive a full go before taking action on restructuring.
 - J. Brit: maybe develop the restructuring proposal in the background while giving the membership drive a full push
 - K. Vote: Passes unanimously to make February an open shopping month for general leave and lapsed/former trial members.
 - L. Plans for February:
 - 1. Another check-in meeting, review full January numbers
 - 2. Keep pushing reminders for buddy system, open shopping
 - 3. Writing copy to send to their peers/groups/networks
 - 4. Developing training/practice for talking about the co-op
