- If there is an issue with a file, contact me and inquire about the file *politely*.
- I compiled this art for fun and in my free time for friends to have easy access to a bunch of Tales art. **If I see excess complaints over stupid minor shit, I will take down the link to these folders.**
- **By using art in these folders, you agree to the rules listed here.**
- Do not ask me where images of certain characters are, that means you didn't read the FAQ.
- All images in these folders are free to download and free to use for non-commercial use.
- If you use them commercially, that's on your ass and not mine.
- These are all official art pieces from various sources, I do not claim ownership over the base images.
- I do not require credit nor do I claim credit for rips/scans/redraws/etc. that are not my own.
- All art and characters belong to Bandai Namco.
- If I sound very harsh, I apologize, but I am very tired of people complaining over shit I do for fun and no profit

FAQ

What sources are the pictures from?

Many are compiled from various wikis, such as Rays, Card Evolve, Link, Crestoria, etc. Others are from the Tales of Transparent blog or Tales of Asteria rips blog. I also take images from the Asteria and Rays Twitters on occasion. They might also be my own screenshots/scans/Tales of Friends chibis labeled "redraw" were redrawn by me and many were color corrected.

Why is there the same picture of a character multiple times?

I generally try not to save duplicates, but in some cases it's just a cropping deal, especially with Asteria. If there are genuine honest to god exact same images, then. Oops. I went through

literally thousands of images and had to cross reference while on the Link wiki with things I already had. If something slipped through, then my bad.

Why are some crossover outfits only labeled “crossover” while others have the series name?

I attempted to go back and update this if I saw it, but I originally saved collaboration outfits as “crossover” and it wasn’t until later that I saved it as the series name.

Why is x character missing?

There’s either no art of them so far or I simply do not like them.

Will you ever compile art for the missing characters?

If it’s a character I do not like, then you would have to [pay me](#). Otherwise you could do it yourself for free. However, with the recent closing of Asteria...I may be inclined to actually compile a couple characters. You’d have to ask nicely, though.

What are the cast folders/multiple character folders for?

In art that features more than one character, I generally try to put them in a multiple character folder. So something that has both Sorey and Mikleo clear and visible in it will go in the Zestiria cast folder. If a character isn’t clear and visible (like just a shitty behind view or their arm or something) then I generally just put it in the main character’s folder.

For art with characters from different games (e.g. Anise and Rose), they get put in the general “multiple characters” folder. Edna and Eizen go in there because they’re from 2 different games.

What are spoiler folders for?

Characters’ forms (generally final bosses) or characters themselves that are spoilers for the game. I can’t guarantee multiple character folders to be spoiler free though.

How often is this updated?

Just whenever. Ever since Crestoria shut down, I've been updating less often as I do not follow Rays or Asteria's updates as closely. I always post when I've done an update in the Discord server.

Why is Kohaku called “the bitch from hearts” in the file names?

I started calling her “the bitch from hearts that doesn't wear pants” or “the bitch from hearts” for short because I could never remember her name. Now I do remember her name, but I kept the nickname as a joke. Since I had already saved so many files with the nickname, before I intended on sharing them with a wider audience, I didn't want to re-save the files. If I genuinely didn't like her she wouldn't be in the folders.

Can I submit art?

Yeah, sure, I guess so.

Will you ever organize the Backgrounds folder so your Google Drive stops trying to crash every time you go to upload folders?

Thanks for the question, me. I'll try to remember to do this someday.
