To the members of the Ithaca community:

Last night, 8 lives were violently taken in Atlanta, Georgia. The connection the shooter had to COVID-related Sinophobia and anti-Asian misogyny is not lost on us. We mourn the lives lost in an act of white supremacy.

We would like to reiterate our previous statement and remind you that we must find strength and safety with each other and not through police intervention. Be wary of official police statements regarding the incident. Do not co-opt the Black Lives Matter movement by using #YellowLivesMatter or #AsianLivesMatter or posting yellow squares. We can create change without appropriating the hard work of Black and brown activists. The tags that are currently being used by the activist community are: #StopAsianHate, #TheyCantBurnUsAll, #ProtectAsianLives, and #AsiansAreHuman.

Finally, we would like to specifically state that we stand in solidarity with sex workers and are fighting for their equal rights as well.
