The program is open to skiers/snowboarders of all levels, including those who have no experience, however, it is highly recommended that students selecting snowboarding have prior ski experience. This year **we are not** able to provide the opportunity for students to take part in the Tube Park. Please ensure to read through the entire package in your Parent Portal and fill out the required information and make your payment.

Students will need to bring a bag lunch, water bottle and proper winter attire.
