

Confidentiality Policy

It is the policy of Math Circles of Chicago that board members and staff of Math Circles of Chicago will not disclose confidential information belonging to, or obtained through their affiliation with, Math Circles of Chicago to any person, including their relatives, friends, and business and professional associates, unless Math Circles of Chicago has authorized disclosure.

Board members and staff are to demonstrate professionalism, good judgment, and care to avoid unauthorized or inadvertent disclosures of confidential information and should, for example, refrain from leaving confidential information contained in documents or on computer screens in plain view.

Upon separation of employment and at the end of a board member's term, he or she shall return all documents, papers, and other materials that may contain confidential information.
