- When should I reach out to professors/mentors for letters of recommendation?
 - Start now!
- What does the match process entail?
 - When you hear back you get an email hearing if you matched or not
- Is it possible to take a gap year before residency?
 - Yes, but you won't be able to match and take a gap year. Taking a gap year in between probably won't put you at a disadvantage either, but you will probably have to discuss your reasoning. It's all a personal decision.
