Protocol for Earbud/Headphone Use

As a formal practice, earbuds/headphones are not to be used during school hours, beginning at 8:00 when students arrive on school property. Staff may choose to allow the use of earbuds/headphones during homeBASE, class periods, or after-school activities. Earbuds/headphones should never be worn outside of the designated activity, such as during passing time, when going to the bathroom, etc.

Protocol for Earbud/Headphone Lessons or Activities

WHEN – Before school, during homeBASE, class periods, and after-school activities.

WHERE – In any learning space.

• As a way to enhance or supplement learning

WHAT – If you would like to have students use their earbuds/headphones for a lesson or activity, what should you do?

- 1. Direct students to take out and use their earbuds/headphones during the activity.
- 2. Direct students to put them away when the activity is completed.

WHY - What are the positive impacts of this practice?

- Ensures that students are present and focused in the classroom so that no learning time is lost.
- Provides opportunities for students to interact and practice their age-appropriate social and communication skills, and to connect with adults in the school to build relationships.
- Ensures immediate awareness of any emergency announcement or situations, especially while outside of the classroom.
