These financial awards are for students planning to attend community college, vocational-technical school, apprenticeship training programs, or equivalent formal career training. Recipients of these awards are selected by the College and Career Access Specialist, Counselors, and the faculty involved in the AVID program.

Requirements for Applicants:

Each applicant must submit the following materials on or before the deadline date:

1. Submit a 300-word essay highlighting future training and career plans and relevant coursework and experience.
2. Submit two character reference letters of recommendation (this can be from trusted adults, teachers, coaches, etc)
3. Include a copy of an unofficial transcript.
4. Attach a typed, detailed resume listing hobbies, work experiences, and relevant activities

If you are selected for this scholarship, you must: (1) attend the Scholarship Reception*, (2) write a thank you card (3) submit your Scholarship Financial Notice on or before your graduation date and (4) Participate in the College Signing Day Assembly/Activity*.
